Kocku von Stuckrad, 2014-05-21 The enigmatic relation between religion and science still presents a challenge to European societies and to ideas about what it means to be modern This book argues that European secularism rather than pushing back religious truth claims in fact has been religiously productive itself The institutional establishment of new disciplines in the nineteenth century such as religious studies anthropology psychology classical studies and the study of various religious traditions led to a professionalization of knowledge about religion that in turn attributed new meanings to religion This attribution of meaning resulted in the emergence of new religious identities and practices In a dynamic that is closely linked to this discursive change the natural sciences adopted religious and metaphysical claims and integrated them in their framework of meaning resulting in a special form of scientific religiosity that has gained much influence in the twentieth century Applying methods that come from historical discourse analysis the book demonstrates that religious semantics have been reconfigured in the secular sciences Ultimately the scientification of religion perpetuated religious truth claims under conditions of secularism

Harry Eiss, 2022-03-22 Do I dare disturb the universe This is a question recognized by people around the world If typed into the internet hundreds of examples appear Many know that it comes from one of the best known poems of the previous century T S Eliot's The Love Song of J Alfred Prufrock What many do not know is that Eliot dramatically shifted his views at the height of his fame for writing such dark poetry as this and The Waste Land becoming a sincere devoted Christian While his poetry is famous because it expresses the loss of a spiritual center in European civilization a careful reading of it reveals that he was struggling with his Christianity from the beginning not rejecting it but trying to make it fit into the contemporary world If the reader works through Eliot's love song for all of the esoteric meanings as he demands it quickly becomes evident that he intended it as a struggle between agape amour and eros Beginning it with a quote from Dante forces that into place Though the protestant forms of Christianity have changed their views on these the Roman Catholic holds fast Eliot references Michelangelo in the poem bringing in the great painter of the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel Most immediately recognize his name and work but do not realize how he expressed a similar personal struggle between the desires of the flesh and the spirit Both of them admired Dante's Divine Comedy and its inclusion of amour as a means to salvation Dante's work is

generally seen as the greatest literature ever to come out of Italy This book is an expanded revision of *Seeking God in the Works of T S Eliot and Michelangelo* It explores how T S Eliot struggled with the highest meanings of existence in his poetry and his own life and perhaps managed to express what has become known as a modernist and post modernist view of what Rudolph Otto designated the *mysterium tremendum* the experience of a mystical awe the experience of God *Inhabiting the Promised Land* Margreet L. resurrection of Eve is indispensable to attaining a true appreciation of love and faith Pilon uses religious texts expert commentary and various works of fiction poetry and psychology to make her argument come alive The work is strengthened by the writing style alternately poetic and humorous and a clear and illuminating progression of ideas Its emphasis on reconciliation and understanding and its post feminist outlook will find a receptive audience *A Brief Apocalyptic History of Psychoanalysis* Carlo Bonomi,2023-02-20 A Brief Apocalyptic History of Psychoanalysis returns us to the birth of psychoanalysis and the trauma of castration that is its umbilicus The story told in this book centers on the genital mutilation endured in her childhood by Emma Eckstein Freud s most important patient in his abandonment of the seduction theory For both cultural and personal reasons Freud could not recognize the traumatic nature of this Beschneidung circumcision which nevertheless aroused in him deep anguish conflating his own circumcision the echoes of a violently anti Semitic environment and conflicts with his father Taking Freud s countertransference to Eckstein s trauma into account leads to a radically different understanding of the origins of psychoanalysis from the one based on the solipsistic perspective of his self analysis Carlo Bonomi argues that the unacknowledged trauma of circumcision was inscribed in Freud s system of thinking as an amputated legacy from which the dreams and fantasies of his closest disciples would germinate and bloom In particular Sándor Ferenczi Freud s pupil and confidant would help to restore this wounded body thereby laying a new foundation for psychoanalytic theory and practice Bonomi s apocalyptic narrative will expand the conceptual horizons of psychoanalysts and psychoanalytic psychotherapists historians of psychoanalysis and scholars of both gender studies and Jewish studies

Representations of Eve in Antiquity and the English Middle Ages John Flood,2010-12-14 As the first woman Eve was the pattern for all her daughters The importance of readings of Eve for understanding how women were viewed at various times is a critical commonplace but one which has been only narrowly investigated This book systematically explores the different ways in which Eve was understood by Christians in antiquity and in the English Middle Ages and it relates these understandings to female social roles The result is an Eve more various than she is often depicted by scholars Beginning with material from the bible the Church Fathers and Jewish sources the book goes on to look at a broad selection of medieval writing including theological works and literary texts in Old and Middle English In addition to dealing with famous authors such as Augustine Aquinas Dante and Chaucer the writings of authors who are now less well known but who were influential in their time are explored The book allows readers to trace the continuities and discontinuities in the way Eve was portrayed over a millennium and a half and as such it is of interest to those interested in women or the bible in the Middle Ages

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
