

How to Format College Essay

Font Size/Style, Margins, and Line Spacing

We suggest you begin by choosing a 12pt font in the Times New Roman style as the default font size and style for essays. This font is universally acceptable for almost every type of academic paper. And please note there is no point in thinking you will get away with writing less by choosing a bigger font size!

When it comes to margin size, we recommend you allow a one-inch margin on all four sides of each page i.e. at the left, right, top, and bottom of all pages. It is easy to create one-inch margins in MS Word. Just follow these steps:

- Choose “Margins” in the “Page Layout” menu.
- Select the option labelled “Normal,” which sets a default margin of one inch on all sides of the page.

Paragraphs should be typed in double line spacing. You can do this in the Microsoft Word software by:

- Selecting the option labelled “Paragraph.”
- Choose the portion you want and right-click on it.
- Choose “Paragraph” and you should see a tab labelled “Indents and Spacing.”
- Now select “Line Spacing,” followed by the option labelled “Double.”

Adding Page Headers to a Paper

Page headings should be placed in the upper left-hand corners of pages. Check that you have indentation set so that it is justified to the left-hand side. It is easy to enable the type of justification you want in MS Word.

The following is the heading format you should use in your essays:

- The header’s first line should contain your own name.
- The next line should contain the name of your teacher or course instructor.
