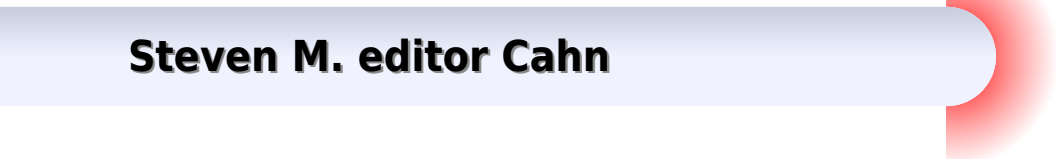

Dodson, 2020-10-06 The topic of human free will has received more attention in the past several years due to the important discoveries of neuroscience but no consensus of opinion is evident in related disciplines The traditional approach to understanding free will in philosophy employs conceptual analysis to determine whether humans have freedom of choice Theology affirms that every person has free choice although God is somehow behind all human decisions Evolutionary psychology points to human behavior as the product of biological processes and antecedent events And neuroethics attempts to define what it means to be a thinking moral agent by investigating how neurons in the brain and chemical interactions combine to produce conscious actions An assessment and evaluation of these various positions is given in light of the evidence The issue of whether a person can be held morally responsible for their actions hinges on whether those actions originate from free will or are the result of determinism Theology makes assumptions of the existence of an absolute deity that has a hand in human decision making but there is no agreement regarding the nature of that intervention Recent scientific discoveries confront traditionally held religious beliefs and necessitate the creation of a new theology and articles of faith

Ethics for Robots Derek Leben,2018-07-17 Ethics for Robots describes and defends a method for designing and evaluating ethics algorithms for autonomous machines such as self driving cars and search and rescue drones Derek Leben argues that such algorithms should be evaluated by how effectively they accomplish the problem of cooperation among self interested organisms and therefore rather than simulating the psychological systems that have evolved to solve this problem engineers should be tackling the problem itself taking relevant lessons from our moral psychology Leben draws on the moral theory of John Rawls arguing that normative moral theories are attempts to develop optimal solutions to the problem of cooperation He claims that Rawlsian Contractarianism leads to the Maximin principle the action that maximizes the minimum value and that the Maximin principle is the most effective solution to the problem of cooperation He contrasts the Maximin principle with other principles and shows how they can often produce non cooperative results Using real world examples such as an autonomous vehicle facing a situation where every action results in harm home care machines and autonomous weapons systems Leben contrasts Rawlsian algorithms with alternatives derived from utilitarianism and natural rights libertarianism Including chapter summaries and a glossary of technical terms Ethics for Robots is essential reading for philosophers engineers computer scientists and cognitive scientists working on the problem of ethics for autonomous systems

A Moral Defense of Recreational Drug Use Rob Lovering, 2015-08-12 Why does American law allow the recreational use of some drugs such as alcohol tobacco and caffeine but not others such as marijuana cocaine and heroin The answer lies not simply in the harm the use of these drugs might cause but in the perceived morality or lack thereof of their recreational use Despite strong rhetoric from moral critics of recreational drug use however it is surprisingly difficult to discern the reasons they have for deeming the recreational use of some drugs morally wrong In this book Rob Lovering lays out and dissects various arguments for the immorality of using marijuana cocaine heroin and other drugs recreationally He contends that by and large these arguments do not succeed Lovering's book represents one of the first works to systematically present analyze and critique arguments for the moral wrongness of recreational drug use Given this as well as the popularity of the morality based defense of the United States drug laws this book is an important and timely contribution to the debate on the recreational use of drugs

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
