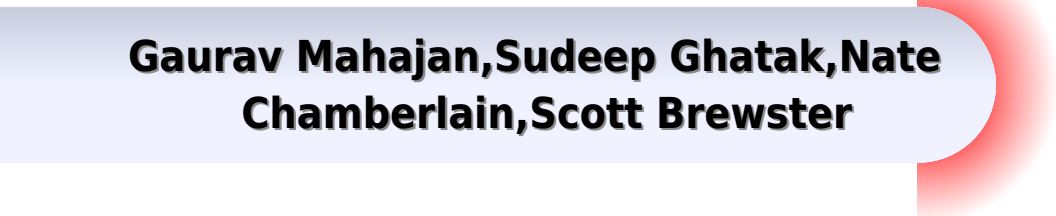
Newsfeed web part provides recent team updates and communication.
