Thus scientia iuris is not the prerogative of a few legal scholars; rather, it lies at the very core of Western legal education and practice broadly understood. The relevance of Siliquini Cinelli's original and interdisciplinary analysis is profound and far-reaching: the crisis that legal education and practice are undergoing is not an isolated or accidental event; it is a consequence of the very ways in which law has been taught, studied, and practised since Rome.
