INTRODUCTION

Pavlov coined the term "reinforcement" in 1903. The concept of reinforcement refers to accomplishing work by providing incentives or rewards to a specific person. Any stimulus that strengthens, encourages, or increases the likelihood of a specific response is referred to as a stimulant.

DEFINITION OF REINFORCEMENT

Reinforcement is an event that increases the likelihood of a response recurrence when a stimulus is produced in similar situations. It is an evidence-based practices for teaching specific skills and increasing desired behaviour. Reinforcement refers to the use of such stimuli, or their presentation or removal, in order to increase the probability of achieving the desired outcome.

For example, a few words of appreciation increase the likelihood of students repeating the same behaviour. In this case, the words of appreciation serve as stimuli, and the students' subsequent behaviour is referred to as the response. Positive and negative reinforcement are the two types of reinforcement. Positive Reinforcement occurs when an event increases the likelihood of a response. Negative Reinforcement occurs when an event reduces the likelihood of a response.

TYPES OF REINFORCEMENT

 Positive reinforcement: The teachers uses the 'accepting statements' in order to make the learning permanent. The teacher encourages the pupils for more participation in the classroom. Sometimes she accepts their ideas by verbal and nonverbal statements. Giving a positive response like 'I understand your viewpoint' 'you have the right to express
