1. Richter Scale: Device used to measure earthquakes.
2. Culture: the total of shared knowledge, shared attitudes, and behaviors of the members of a specific group.
3. Diffusion: the spread of ideas and customs from one society to another.
4. Acculturation: when one society decides to adopt a custom that they observe in another society.
5. Metropolitan Area: a city, along with its suburbs and exurbs.
6. Urbanization: dramatic rise in the number of cities and the resulted lifestyle change.
7. Metis: people of French and Native descent
8. Andes Mountains: range that runs down the western coastline of South America.
9. Greater Antilles: larger islands that include Cuba, Jamaica, Hispaniola, and Puerto Rico.
10. Amazon River: begins in the Andes Mountains and flows eastward across South America
11. Tenochtitlan: The Aztec capital that became Mexico City
12. Biodiversity: a wide range of plants, insects, and wildlife
13. North Atlantic Drift: a current of warm water from the tropics
