

Formation of a New Government

3. In 1791, the Legislative Assembly is formed. Citizens gained broad voting rights, but rights were not universal. Constitution restricted power of king and ended distinctions of birth. King and queen feared they would be harmed.

Foreign Powers

- Austria and Prussia warned against harming monarchs
- Austrian army defeats French
- Financial strain of war, food shortages, and high prices
- King blamed; action demanded

End of Monarchy

- August 10, 1792 royal family imprisoned by mob
- **Radical** faction took charge with National Convention
- Monarchy abolished; France declared a republic

French revolutionary troops won the Battle of Valmy. New French republic held ground against Europe's Old Order.
