The short story is probably the most popular literary form among readers, but, strangely, it remains the least discussed among literary critics. This paradox typifies the odd but fascinating history of the form. The short story was the last major literary form to develop. Although various forms of storytelling have existed as long as human civilization, the particular way of shaping a narrative that we now conventionally—and, let us admit it, arbitrarily—call "the short story" emerged only in the early nineteenth century. When in 1837 Nathaniel Hawthorne published Tinice-Told Tales, the volume usually considered the beginning of the English-language short story, poetry and drama had already flourished for millennia. Short prose forms like the parable and fable dated back nearly as long. Even the novel, a relative newcomer in literature, had existed for nearly two centuries. Among these literary senior citizens, the short story emerged as a dynamic and distinctly modern innovation.

What was new and different about the short story compared with earlier types of short fiction? Critics have argued that question for almost two centuries. Not surprisingly—since they are critics—they are still arguing. But readers and writers recognized at once the special power and innovation of the form. The short story did at least three things that changed the way brief fiction was told. First, it condensed the action of the tale—usually into a single situation focused on a single character. All of the dramatic and narrative power of the story was compressed into exploring that one action—its motivations. unfolding, and effects. Such narrative compression helped create a second innovation. It encouraged deeper characterization of the protagonist often by depicting his or her inner life as well as outer circumstances, which gave the short story a heightened sense of realism. Finally, the short story used prose in a poetic manner. Sound and rhythm, image and symbol, tone and point of view were carefully crafted to communicate not merely the plot but the physical and emotional experience of the tale. What resulted was a way of telling stories that was more unified, intense, and expressive than anything nineteenthcentury readers had previously known. And the public was captivated.
