Well armed and armoured this professional army was trained to operate within self supporting legions with auxiliaries employed in roles the legions lacked such as light troops or cavalry. The Roman legions were in many ways a modern force with formations designed around tactical goals and held together by discipline training and common purpose. The armies fielded by the tribes of Gaul were for the most part lightly armed and armoured with fine cavalry and a well deserved reputation for ferocity. As might be expected from a region made up of different tribes with a range of needs and interests there was no consensus on how to make war though when large armies were gathered it was usually with the express purpose of bringing the enemy to heel in a pitched battle. For most Gauls and certainly the military elites of the tribes battle was an opportunity to prove their personal courage and skill raising their status in the eyes of friends and foes alike. Fully illustrated this study investigates the Roman and Gallic forces pitched into combat in three battles Bibracte 58 BC Sabis 57 BC and Gergovia Alesia 52 BC.
