#### Structure of lab report (100 points total)

- 1) Scientific title (5 points): Contains a few key words that describe the experiment and its purpose. In your title, include the name of your unknown microbe and the unknown ID NUMBER that the instructor assigned to you!
- 2) Abstract (20 points): No longer than 1 page in length, double spaced and no Shorter than ½ page double spaced. The abstract effectively summarize your entire lab report. Start your Abstract with a sentence describing what your "unknown microbe" project was about and what your unknown microbe was determined to be. Include a summary of importance of your unknown microbe and its characteristics/pathogenesis. Include a summary of any methodologies and experimental procedures used to determine what your unknown microbe was in 1 2 sentences. Brief summary of the important results you obtained from the tests you ran on your unknown microbe that determined what your unknown was. Include a concluding sentence. (For example: "I determined my unknown microbe to be Staphylococcal aureus, a Gram positive cocci bacteria, based on the selective and differential tests described in this report." Your abstract should not have any references since it should be in your own words.
- 3) Introduction (20 points): No longer than 2 page in length, double spaced and no shorter than ½ page double spaced. The Introduction should be at least 2 to 3 paragraphs. Describe the various stains, selective and differential media, and other tests (such as the catalase and oxidase) used to identify microbes. Please include a flow chart diagram in identifying unknown microbes, especially the ones we used in our lab. The Flow chart is part of the 2 page limit for the introduction.
