4. Completion of all required semester hours must be completed to earn a bachelor's degree.
5. At least two high school credits in one foreign language or American Sign Language, or two semesters of study with pass/no-pass in college foreign language or American Sign Language at the college level are required for graduation from TAMU-CC. This requirement is waived by earning a CLIP score equivalent to one year of college-level foreign language study. International students who have successfully taken the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or have successfully completed the English as a Second Language International (ESLI) course of study may also complete English as their second language to meet the foreign language requirement. English is considered the first language for all other students.
6. Computer competency must be met for graduation. Please see the University catalog for more information.
7. Students are advised to contact a TAMU-CC academic advisor upon transferring to TAMU-CC.
