names in his old age He died unmarried in the year 1797 at the age of eighty He had turned his house at Strawberry Hill by the Thames near Twickenham into a Gothic villa eighteenth century Gothic and amused himself by spending freely upon its adornment with such things as were then fashionable as objects of taste But he delighted also in his flowers and his trellises of roses and the quiet Thames When confined by gout to his London house in Arlington Street flowers from Strawberry Hill and a bird were necessary consolations.
