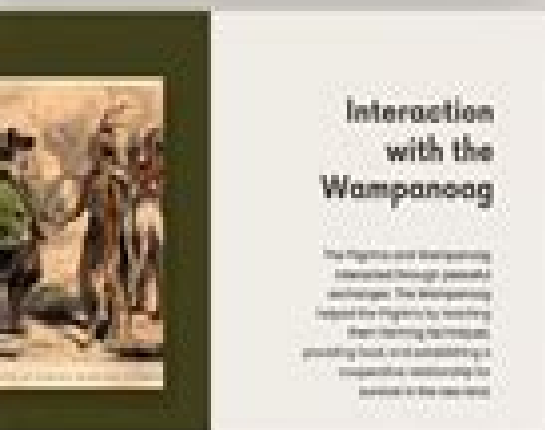


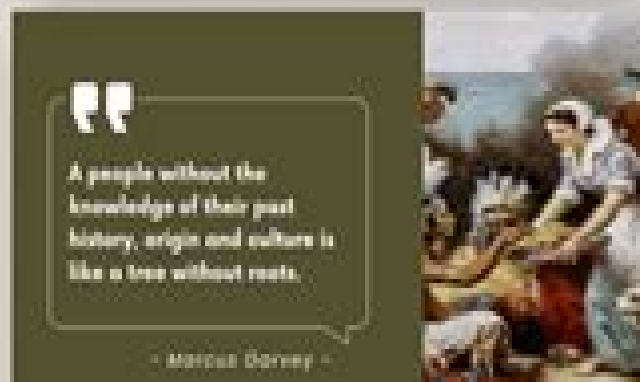


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Using New Technologies to Enhance Teaching and Learning in History Terry Haydn, 2013-02-11 Nearly all history
