accordingly This paper identifies institutional and structural gaps and assesses the effectiveness of monetary policy transmission Institutional gaps are assessed using institutional indexes while transmission is assessed using VARs It concludes that in the coming years reforms will need to continue to further improve the CBU s governance and independence develop financial markets but most of all to reduce the still large footprint of the state in the financial sector as well as in the overall economy
