Key Points to cover:

- Why the problems and policies of Louis XVI reached crisis point in 1789 and why his management of this crisis, led to revolutionary change in France.

What were the problems and policies of Louis XVI?

He ruled under a absolute monarchy, but because of the many regional differences his orders were rarely ever properly carried out. He was weak and indecisive and reluctant to accept the reality of the situation he found himself in.

After Calonne, He refused to show the Assembly of Notables (A group of noblemen or senior members of the Church) an accurate record of the royal finances but refused and caused great anxiety and a protest among the educated public. Which eventually marked the start of the financial and political crisis in France that led to the revolution itself in 1789.

His Management of this crisis:

This began a widespread revolt as the King still refused to provide accurate accounts of the royal accounts to the parliament of Paris. The financial and political crisis continued throughout 1787 and 1788, as the king continued to mismanage the parliament, division came between the nobility and clergy concerning whether they should still have their privileges. Since the king did not know what to do he decided to summon the Estates General, which hasn't met in over a century. While the king's purpose for the meeting was to solve the financial crisis of France it led to the obvious two sides going against the Third Estate.

Out of anger the third estate formed the National Assembly, and then the king tried to stop their meeting, but they simply went to a tennis court, which became known as the "Tennis court Oath." This was critical to the becoming of the revolution.

In 1789, all these tensions that the king caused the country to now move in a more radical direction.

- He refused to give any power to the National Assembly, and wanted the Estates General to act as it was before (first and second estate overpowering the third estate) which set to them off
