topographic complexity of reefs redirects mainstream currents creates tidal eddies mushroom jets boundary layers stagnation zones and this turbulence is enhanced by the oceanographic chaos in the adjoining Coral Sea This is the environment in which particles and organisms of a range of sizes live from tiny plankton to megafauna This generates faunal connectivity at scales of meters to thousands of km within the Great Barrier Reef and with the adjoining ocean Pollution from land use is increasing and remedial measures are described both on land and on coral cays The impact of climate change is quantified in case studies about mangroves and corals Modelling this biophysical complexity is increasing in sophistication and the authors suggest how the field can advance further
