

Graduation Welcome Speech – June 2010

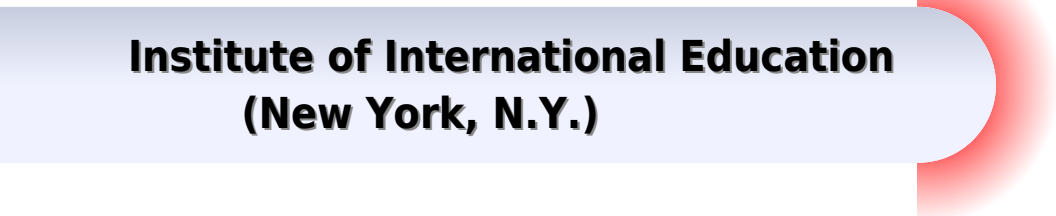
It is my pleasure to welcome families, friends, teachers, and our younger students to graduation day at Wilmington Montessori School.
