and Cambodia where the winners were utopians who purged libraries in efforts to purify their societies and maintain power Part III examines the fate of libraries when there is war and a resulting power vacuum The book concludes with a discussion of the events in Iraq in 2003 and the responsibility of American war strategists for the widespread pillaging that ensued after the toppling of Saddam Hussein This case poignantly demonstrates the ease with which an oppressed people given the collapse of civil restraints may claim freedom as license for anarchy construing it as the right to prevail while ignoring its implicit mandate of social responsibility Using military might to enforce ideals in this case democracy and freedom is futile Knuth argues if insufficient consideration is given to humanitarian security and cultural concerns
