Aristocratic Education and the Making of the American Republic Mark Boonshoft, 2020-06-30 Following the American Revolution it was a cliché that the new republic's future depended on widespread informed citizenship However instead of immediately creating the common schools accessible elementary education that seemed necessary to create such a citizenry the Federalists in power founded one of the most ubiquitous but forgotten institutions of early American life academies privately run but state chartered secondary schools that offered European style education primarily for elites By 1800 academies had become the most widely incorporated institutions besides churches and transportation projects in nearly every state In this book Mark Boonshoft shows how many Americans saw the academy as a caricature of aristocratic European education and how their political reaction against the academy led to a first era of school reform in the United States helping transform education from a tool of elite privilege into a key component of self government And yet the very anti aristocratic critique that propelled democratic education was conspicuously silent on the persistence of racial and gender inequality in public schooling By tracing the history of academies in the revolutionary era Boonshoft offers a new understanding of political power and the

origins of public education and segregation in the United States

Klarman,2016-09-16 Americans revere their Constitution However most of us are unaware how tumultuous and improbable the drafting and ratification processes were As Benjamin Franklin keenly observed any assembly of men bring with them all their prejudices their passions their errors of opinion their local interests and their selfish views One need not deny that the Framers had good intentions in order to believe that they also had interests Based on prodigious research and told largely through the voices of the participants Michael Klarman's *The Framers Coup* narrates how the Framers' clashing interests shaped the Constitution and American history itself The Philadelphia convention could easily have been a failure and the risk of collapse was always present Had the convention dissolved any number of adverse outcomes could have resulted including civil war or a reversion to monarchy Not only does Klarman capture the knife-edge atmosphere of the convention he populates his narrative with riveting and colorful stories the rebellion of debtor farmers in Massachusetts George Washington's uncertainty about whether to attend Gunning Bedford's threat to turn to a European prince if the small states were denied equal representation in the Senate slave states' threats to take their marbles and go home if denied representation for their slaves Hamilton's quasi-monarchist speech to the convention and Patrick Henry's herculean efforts to defeat the Constitution in Virginia through demagoguery and conspiracy theories *The Framers Coup* is more than a compendium of great stories however and the powerful arguments that feature throughout will reshape our understanding of the nation's founding Simply put the Constitutional Convention almost didn't happen and once it happened it almost failed And even after the convention succeeded the Constitution it produced almost failed to be ratified Just as importantly the Constitution was hardly the product of philosophical reflections by brilliant disinterested statesmen but rather ordinary interest group politics Multiple conflicting interests had a say from creditors and debtors to city dwellers and backwoodsmen The upper class overwhelmingly supported the Constitution many working class colonists were more dubious Slave states and nonslave states had different perspectives on how well the Constitution served their interests Ultimately both the Constitution's content and its ratification process raise troubling questions about democratic legitimacy The Federalists were eager to avoid full-fledged

democratic deliberation over the Constitution and the document that was ratified was stacked in favor of their preferences And in terms of substance the Constitution was a significant departure from the more democratic state constitutions of the 1770s Definitive and authoritative The Framers Coup explains why the Framers preferred such a constitution and how they managed to persuade the country to adopt it We have lived with the consequences both positive and negative ever since
