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The Authoritarian Divide Orçun Selçuk, 2024-07-15. In the context of the global decline of democracy, *The Authoritarian Divide* analyzes the tactics that populist leaders in Turkey, Venezuela, and Ecuador have used to polarize their countries. Political polarization is traditionally viewed as the result of competing left-right ideologies. In *The Authoritarian Divide*, Orçun Selçuk argues that regardless of ideology, polarization is driven by dominant populist leaders who deliberately divide constituents by cultivating a dichotomy of inclusion and exclusion. This practice, known as affective leader polarization, stifles compromise and undermines the democratic process. Drawing on multiple qualitative and quantitative methodologies for support, as well as content from propaganda media such as public speeches, Muhtar Meetings, *Al Presidente*, and *Enlace Ciudadano*, Selçuk details and analyzes the tactics used by three well-known populist leaders to fuel affective leader polarization: Recep Tayyip Erdoğan in Turkey, Hugo Chávez in Venezuela, and Rafael Correa in Ecuador. Selçuk's work provides a rubric for a better understanding of and potential defense against the rise in polarizing populism across the globe.

Amazons in America Keira V. Williams, 2019-03-06. With this remarkable study, historian Keira V. Williams shows how fictional matriarchies produced for specific audiences in successive eras and across multiple media constitute prescriptive, solution-oriented thought experiments directed at contemporary social issues. In the process, *Amazons in America* uncovers a rich tradition of matriarchal popular culture in the United States. Beginning with late nineteenth-century anthropological studies which theorized a universal prehistoric matriarchy, Williams explores how representations of women-centered societies reveal changing ideas of gender and power over the course of the twentieth century and into the present day. She examines a deep archive of cultural artifacts, both familiar and obscure, including L. Frank Baum's *The Wizard of Oz* series, Progressive-era fiction like Charlotte Perkins Gilman's utopian novel *Herland*, the original 1940s *Wonder Woman* comics, midcentury films featuring nuclear families, and feminist science-fiction novels from the 1970s that invented prehistoric and futuristic matriarchal societies. While such texts have at times served as sites of feminist theory, Williams unpacks their cyclical nature and, in doing so, pinpoints some of the premises that have historically hindered gender equality in the United States. Williams also delves into popular works from the twenty-first

century such as Tyler Perry's *Madea* franchise and DC Comics Warner Bros globally successful film *Wonder Woman* which attest to the ongoing presence of matriarchal ideas and their capacity for combating patriarchy and white nationalism with visions of rebellion and liberation. *Amazons in America* provides an indispensable critique of how anxieties and fantasies about women in power are culturally expressed ultimately informing a broader discussion about how to nurture a stable equitable society.

Queer Jewish Strangers in American Popular Culture Amy Tziporah Karp, 2023-12-19 *Queer Jewish Strangers in American Popular Culture* Life Between Assimilation and Otherness explores LGBTQIA Jewish American identity in the United States and the queer Jewish stranger figures who live in between incorporation and estrangement. Amy Tziporah Karp establishes that despite the near ubiquitous portrayal of Jewish American assimilation as a finished project completed in the wake of World War II in academic disciplines and throughout popular culture many LGBTQIA Jewish figures in contemporary popular culture inhabit stranger positionalities. In these stranger spaces characters are forced to either perpetually attempt to assimilate or inhabit this interstitial stranger identity that is often viewed as a nowhere or homeless space. Those who pursue assimilating endlessly try to fit in to no avail such as Jenny Schecter from Showtime's popular *The L Word* who is ultimately killed off on the show possibly murdered by her LGBTQIA community of friends. Karp shows that those who attempt to make a home in a stranger positionality align themselves with other estranged and othered peoples such as characters throughout Sarah Schulman's novels and that this constitutes an ethical stance against the ways in which assimilation often inadvertently supports the workings of violent hegemonies in the United States.
