The Odyssey of an African Slave Sitiki, 2009-09-27 Recently discovered as a hand written document in the Buckingham Smith Collection at the New York Historical Society this remarkable first person narrative traces the life of Sitiki whose name was changed to Jack Smith after his enslavement in America Captured and sold into slavery in Africa as a five year old Sitiki traveled to America as a cabin boy Eventually sold by the ship s captain to Josiah Smith of Savannah Georgia he lived there and in Connecticut with his new master Captured by the British during the War of 1812 he was returned to the Smiths to be freed only after the Civil War He went on to become the first black Methodist minister in St Augustine Florida where he established his own church Patricia Griffin does not leave the story at the conclusion of the slave narrative but explores Sitiki s experiences and places them in clear and valuable context She presents the narrative unencumbered allowing Sitiki s authority compassion and personality to speak for itself

Barry Teichroeb, 2025-05-29 The cultural group associated with the Russian Mennonites was born during the tumultuous period of the Anabaptist Movement in the early 16th century stemming from the Protestant Reformation in the Lowland countries of western Europe Viewed on a 21st century map this region encompasses parts of northern France Belgium the Netherlands and parts of the Rhine River basin in western Germany Foundational political and religious principles evolved as this Mennonite group established its identity freedom of religion separation of Church and State exemption from military service adult baptism and disintermediation of the Clergy The Anabaptist movement posed a serious threat to the Church of Rome and the Holy Roman Empire Fervent violent attempts were made to stamp out the movement driving congregants underground or sweeping them northward as the Inquisition sought out captured and murdered Anabaptist heretics The Mennonites fled through the northern territories of the Netherlands and into safer regions such as the Polish Lithuanian Commonwealth and the city of Danzig where some religious toleration existed Danzig became a hub of Mennonite settlement and other centers emerged particularly in the Polish Lithuanian Commonwealth as the community expanded Until the late 18th century these Mennonites were able to live according to their principles and succeed In the latter half of the 18th century European political tensions and conflicts led to the partitioning and eventual dissolution of the Polish Lithuanian Commonwealth and some the most important privileges enjoyed by the Mennonites were lost among them the unfettered right to acquire land and exemption from military service In the last years of the 18th century Russia under Catherine the Great began a program to encourage settlement by foreigners in her vast western regions The Mennonite community regarded this as a salvation and carved out a new life on the steppes along the Dneiper River beginning in the last decade of the 18th century For nearly a century these Mennonites lived in Russia able to abide by their principles However political encroachment on their systems of education and governance and threats to their deeply held principles caused a new migration this time to North America Many Russian Mennonites came to Canada They arrived in three waves in the 1870s
