

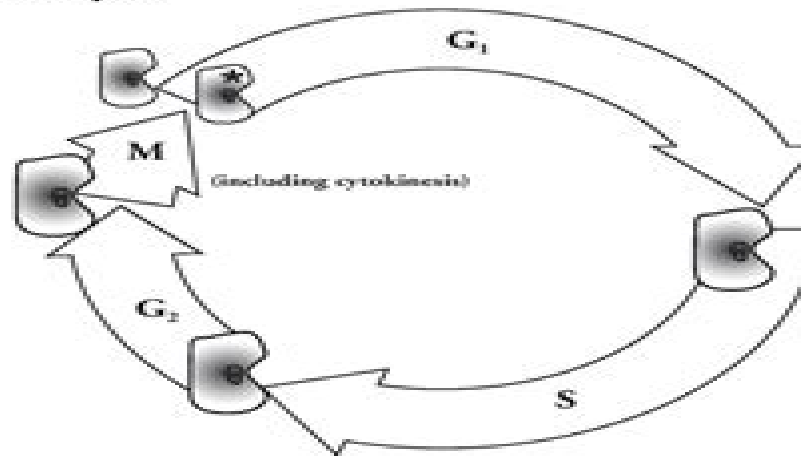
The Cell Cycle
