Regan, 2017-01-01 The underappreciated but surprisingly successful implementation of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act ARRA helped rescue the economy during the Great Recession and represented one of the most important achievements of the Obama presidency It tested all levels of government with urgent time frames and extensive accountability requirements While ARRA passed most tests with comparatively little mismanagement or fraud negative public and media perceptions of the initiative deprived the president of political credit Drawing on more than two hundred interviews and nationwide field research *Governing under Stress* examines a range of ARRA stimulus programs to analyze the fraught politics complex implementation and impact of the legislation Essays from public administration scholars use ARRA to study how to implement large federal programs in our modern era of indirect networked governance Throughout the contributors present potent insights into the most pressing challenges facing public policy and management and they uncover important lessons about policy instruments and networks the effects of transparency and accountability and the successes and failures of different types of government intervention

Trading with the Enemy Hugo Meijer, 2016 In light of the intertwining logics of military competition and economic interdependence at play in US China relations *Trading with the Enemy* examines how the United States has balanced its potentially conflicting national security and economic interests in its relationship with the People's Republic of China PRC To do so Hugo Meijer investigates a strategically sensitive yet under explored facet of US China relations the making of American export control policy on military related technology transfers to China since 1979 *Trading with the Enemy* is the first monograph on this dimension of the US China relationship in the post Cold War Based on 199 interviews declassified documents and diplomatic cables leaked by Wikileaks two major findings emerge from this book First the US is no longer able to apply a strategy of military technology containment of China in the same way it did with the Soviet Union during the Cold War This is because of the erosion of its capacity to restrict the transfer of military related technology to the PRC Secondly a growing number of actors in Washington have reassessed the nexus between national security and economic interests at stake in the US China relationship by moving beyond the Cold War trade off between the two in order to maintain American military preeminence vis vis its strategic rivals By focusing on how states manage the heterogeneous and potentially competing security and economic interests at stake in a bilateral relationship this book seeks to shed light on the evolving character of interstate rivalry in a globalized economy where rivals in the military realm are also economically interdependent

Ford, 2021-01-01 Education policy and policy making is shaped through the activities of a complex network of educators educational leaders researchers community members as well as government and non government officials and organizations

Educational researchers are a critical player in this complex network and their investigations of various educational phenomena can answer questions relevant to the design and implementation of education policy for school improvement. Educational research however often has limited influence in larger policy conversations and decisions (Orland 2009) and this is due to many factors. Educational researchers can provide an evidence based starting place for discussions about school improvement with the complex network of stakeholders engaged in policy development and implementation but they must be more intentionally and systematically thoughtful about the connections of their work to policy and policy making. Furthermore researchers can increase the relevance of their work for policy through the careful design and framing of research in collaboration with end users and an awareness of its implications. In so doing researchers can spur the interest and dissemination of their findings to wider audiences. This book offers resources for education researchers, faculty and advanced graduate students interested in maximizing the relevance of their research on policy for school improvement. In achieving this purpose the book is organized into three sections: 1 A primer for education policy making in the United States, 2 Designing research to maximize education policy relevance and 3 Engaging users of research to communicate its relevance to policymakers. This book is primarily for education researchers, faculty and advanced graduate students seeking to improve the visibility and impact of their research on school improvement particularly in the realm of educational policy and policy making. While this book is a volume in the book series for the American Educational Research Association Special Interest Group Leadership for School Improvement, the importance and usefulness of the topics covered span education research more broadly. Further the content of this book serves as a comprehensive guide for how education researchers in general can better situate their work to influence policy. The book is intended to be utilized by university scholars, graduate students in research or policy courses, post doctoral fellows as well as research associates or directors in various organizations relevant to education such as research consulting groups, non profits which serve education, teacher unions, state agencies or state level educator organizations, associations and think tanks. Emerging or established researchers in any of these organizations who want to increase the relevance, significance and dissemination of their work into education policy will hopefully find this book useful.
