Gymnastics of the Mind Raffaella Cribiore, 2005-02-13 This book is at once a thorough study of the educational system for the Greeks of Hellenistic and Roman Egypt and a window to the vast panorama of educational practices in the Greco-Roman world. It describes how people learned, taught and practiced literate skills, how schools functioned and what the curriculum comprised. Raffaella Cribiore draws on over 400 papyri, ostraca, sherds of pottery or slices of limestone and tablets that feature everything from exercises involving letters of the alphabet through rhetorical compositions that represented the work of advanced students. The exceptional wealth of surviving source material renders Egypt an ideal space of reference. The book makes excursions beyond Egypt as well, particularly in the Greek East, by examining the letters of the Antiochene Libanius that are concerned with education. The first part explores the conditions for teaching and learning and the roles of teachers, parents and students in education; the second vividly describes the progression from elementary to advanced education. Cribiore examines not only school exercises but also books and commentaries employed in education, an uncharted area of research. This allows the most comprehensive evaluation thus far of the three main stages of a liberal education: from the elementary teacher to the grammarian to the rhetorician. Also addressed in unprecedented detail are female education and the role of families in education. *Gymnastics of the Mind* will be an indispensable resource to students and scholars of the ancient world and of the history of education.

Manuscripts, Texts, Theology David C. Parker, 2009-07-14 David C. Parker is one of the world's foremost specialists in the study of the New Testament text and of Greek and Latin manuscripts. In addition to editions, monographs and more popular writings, he has published many articles on different aspects of textual criticism. This volume brings together twenty-five of them in a revised and updated version. The collection is divided into three topics. The first deals with manuscript studies. As well as three very different studies of Codex Bezae, there are articles and reports on individual manuscripts and classes of manuscripts and reports on visits to libraries. The second section has the theme of textual criticism. It includes broader studies dealing with the theory of the discipline and more detailed discussions of particular problems, including translations into Latin, techniques for grouping Greek manuscripts and the comparison of modern editions. The third section contains papers in which Parker has discussed the often overlooked relationship between textual criticism and theology. These studies explore particular textual problems and their wider significance and cover topics as varied as Jesus and Textual Criticism, Calvin's Biblical Text and The Early Tradition of Jesus Sayings on Divorce.

The Heresy of Orthodoxy (Foreword by I. Howard Marshall) Andreas J. Köstenberger, Michael J. Kruger, 2010-06-09 Beginning with Walter Bauer in 1934, the denial of clear orthodoxy in early Christianity has shaped and largely defined modern New Testament criticism, recently given new life through the work of spokesmen like Bart Ehrman.

Spreading from academia into mainstream media the suggestion that diversity of doctrine in the early church led to many competing orthodoxies is indicative of today's postmodern relativism. Authors K. Stenberger and Kruger engage Ehrman and others in this polemic against a dogged adherence to popular ideals of diversity. K. Stenberger and Kruger's accessible and careful scholarship not only counters the Bauer Thesis using its own terms but also engages overlooked evidence from the New Testament. Their conclusions are drawn from analysis of the evidence of unity in the New Testament, the formation and closing of the canon and the methodology and integrity of the recording and distribution of religious texts within the early church.
