the first three reinterpretations of ressentiment are already implied in the theater set up in Nietzsche's late polemical books while the fourth proposes a line of flight out of it. The *Dialectic of Ressentiment* will be of interest to scholars and advanced students working in critical theory, social and political philosophy, cultural studies, sociology, history, literature, political science, anthropology, and Nietzsche scholarship. It will also appeal to anyone interested in the politics of anger, discourse, ethics, trauma studies, and memory politics.
