NOTICE ON 2024 INTAKE UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS (UEE)

The Catholic University of Malawi will on **Saturday, November 25, 2023**, administer university entrance examinations for all eligible candidates at the following centres: the Catholic University of Malawi, Montfort Main Campus in Nguludi (Chiradzulu), St. John's Secondary School in Area 36, Lilongwe (Opposite Partners in Hope Hospital), and Mary Mount Secondary School in Mzuzu. **Time: 8:00 a.m. (Please, note that the venue in the northern region has changed from Mzuzu Technical College to Mary Mount Secondary School)**

ELIGIBILITY

(a) The Entrance Examinations are open to all those who meet the minimum entry qualification, which is the Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent, with **credit passes in six subjects, including English**. The aggregate score in the best six subjects must not exceed **thirty (30) points**.

(b) Those who have not submitted the application forms in time before the deadline of November 11, 2023, but meet the minimum entry qualifications are also encouraged to report to the centres with the following:

- Two recent passport-size photographs
- Original copy of the certificate or notification of results slip.
- A deposit slip worth K10,000 was deposited into one of the following bank accounts:

Candidates are asked to bring the following items on the day of registration and examination:

Please **NOTE** that those who are undergoing the bridging programme, those who applied from foreign countries using foreign certificates, and those who applied using "A" level or post secondary certificates are **NOT** required to write university entrance examinations. **THE UNIVERSITY SHALL NOT RELEASE** a list of names prior to 25 November for candidates to write the Exams.

Pathways to Prosperity in Rural Malawi Andrew Dabalen, Alejandro de la Fuente, Aparajita Goyal, Wendy Karamba, Tomomi Tanaka, 2017-07-06 By most accounts rural Malawi has lacked dynamism in the past decade Growth has been mostly volatile in large part due to unstable macroeconomic fundamentals evidenced by high inflation fiscal deficits and interest rates When rapid economic growth has materialized the gains have not always reached the poorest Poverty remains high and the rural poor face significant challenges in consistently securing enough food Several factors contribute to stubbornly high rural poverty They include a low productivity and non diversified agriculture macroeconomic and recurrent climatic shocks limited non farm opportunities and low returns to such activities especially for the poor and poor performance from some of the prominent safety net programs The Report proposes complementary policy actions that offer a possible path for a more dynamic and prosperous rural economy The key pillars of this comprise macroeconomic stability increased productivity in agriculture faster urbanization better functioning safety nets and more inclusive financial markets Some recommendations call for a reorientation of existing programs such as the Malawi Farm Input Subsidy Program FISP and the Malawi Social Action Fund Public Works Program MASAF PWP Others identify promising new areas of intervention such as the introduction of digital IDs and biometric technologies to enhance the reach of mobile banking and deepen financial inclusion Finally and importantly the report recommends the scaling up of investments on girls secondary education to curb early child marriage and early child bearing among adolescents This will empower women at home and work and bend the trajectory of fertility rates in rural areas in order to boost human development and reduce poverty

The post World War II colonial reconstruction programmes for economic recovery and general political and social development in Malawi then known as Nyasaland necessitated increased education But the sincerity of metropolitan development plans for the colonies could only be adequately appraised through the degree of demonstrated commitment in the implementation of the announced plans This study seeks to examine chronologically the development and application of colonial education policies during the period 1945 to 1961 in Malawi The parties involved included the British Colonial Office the Nyasaland Protectorate Government and the Christian missionaries on the one hand and the European settlers Asian Coloured and African communities on the other as the target groups of the policies Devising educational policies of equitable benefit to all the racial and social groupings in Malawi posed enormous problems to the colonial administration This study examining the dynamics and course of policy contends that given the prevailing economic and political conditions non European education especially that of Africans experienced retardation in favour of European education Sometimes apparent government ineptitude combined with calculated needs for the Europeans produced under development for African education in Malawi and the country's economy In the end African education operated against the odds of missionary and government apathy This book discusses the impact on education generally of the Nyasaland Post War Development Programme the Colonial Office Commissions of 1947 1951 and 1961 and the local Committees set up to inquire into the retardation of African education in its various categories including female and Muslim in response to both local and international pressure Although considered a priority African education developed slowly contrary to the declared goal of Post War colonial policy of self determination with its potential demands for trained local manpower The argument demonstrates the tenacity of the Federal Government of Rhodesia and Nyasaland in playing down African education as a political strategy from 1953 to 1961 at the same time as it accorded a better deal to Asian and Coloured education
