Thousands of irreplaceable junior officers and NCOs were dead wounded or prisoners Renowned Eastern Front expert Prit Buttar expertly brings these contrasting fortunes to life trends which culminated in the huge battles of Bagration As this masterful study conclusively shows in 1944 the Red Army finally put together a campaign that utterly destroyed the German Army Group Centre The Wehrmacht suffered the loss of over 300 000 men killed wounded or taken prisoner and the Red Army rolled forward across Belarus to the outskirts of Warsaw The end of the war was still many months away and the Germans managed to reconstruct their line on the Eastern Front but final victory for the Soviet Union was now only a matter of time as a direct consequence of Bagration

Livingstone, 2024 A social history of West Germany s Bundesgrenzschutz BGS Federal Border Police that complicates the telling of the country s history as a straightforward success story The 2020 murder of George Floyd by Minneapolis police officers shows that police violence is still a problem in Western democracies Floyd s murder prompted some critics to hail the German police as a model of democratic policing that should be emulated After 1945 Germany s police forces had supposedly shed the militarization and authoritarian impulses still prevalent in other nations forces These uncritical appraisals however deserve closer analysis This book is a social history of West Germany s Bundesgrenzschutz BGS a federal border guard established in 1951 that became re unified Germany s first national police force It argues that the BGS revived authoritarian traditions of militarized policing and kept them alive long into the postwar era even though the country was supposedly consigning these problematic legacies to its past The BGS was staffed and led by Wehrmacht and SS veterans until the late 1970s and while West Germany was democratizing BGS commanders were still planning to fight wars and were teaching its officers street fighting tactics While the end outcome was positive the study contributes to the growing body of recent research that complicates the writing of the Federal Republic s history as a success story Dealing explicitly with post fascist

West Germany's struggle to establish a democratic police force the book enters a conversation with studies concerned with democratization security and Germany's effort to overcome its Nazi past DAVID M LIVINGSTONE holds a PhD in History from the University of California San Diego He is retired as Chief of Police of Simi Valley California and is an adjunct professor at California Lutheran University

The Wehrmacht's Last Stand Robert M. in and of themselves as individuals He contrasts this with Adolf Hitler's life and his ideology of children that children are nothing more than tools of the state And throughout Marrin draws readers into the Warsaw Ghetto What it was like How it was run How Jews within and Poles without responded Who worked to save lives and who tried to enrich themselves on other people's suffering And how one man came to represent the conscience and the soul of humanity Filled with black and white photographs this is an unforgettable portrait of a man whose compassion in even the darkest hours reminds us what is possible

Ground Combat Ben Connable,2025 Ground Combat reveals the gritty details of land warfare at the tactical level and challenges the overly subjective and often inaccurate American approach to characterizing war Ben Connable's motivation for writing the book is to replace overly subjective analyses with an evidence based approach to examining war From analyzing a set of over 400 global ground combat cases Connable shows there has been a modest and evolutionary shift in the characteristics of ground combat from World War II through the early 2020s This evidence of gradual change repudiates the popular but often hyperbolic arguments about military technical revolutions and that there is a singular character of war in the modern era Connable identifies past and current weaknesses in military design and strategy examines common characteristics in modern ground combat from the data and reframes the debate over the historical and prospective impact of emerging technologies on war Ground Combat sets an evidentiary baseline and a new detail oriented standard for conflict research and policymaking

[A Tailor in Auschwitz](#) David van Turnhout,Dirk Verhofstadt,2022-09-22 David Van Turnhout and Dirk Verhofstadt traced the story of David's Jewish grandfather Ide Leib Kartuz Fleeing from antisemitism and violence he came to Antwerp in 1929 and set up business as a tailor The family he left behind ended up in the ghetto of Radomsko Each and every member of the family was gassed at Treblinka In Belgium Kartuz joined the resistance movement but was arrested by the Nazis in 1942 and deported to Auschwitz On arrival there his wife and two children immediately died a horrible death He survived in a unit of tailors where he repaired camp clothing and SS guards uniforms sometimes receiving special orders from SS officers Kartuz endured an inhuman death march to Mauthausen After the war back in Antwerp he made tailored suits for bankers and other business people His final battle was against the Belgian state for recognition as a Belgian citizen member of the resistance and war victim Very few people realise how difficult it was for Jewish people to survive after liberation The authors dig deep into the core of the Holocaust and investigate every trail from Radomsko to Miami In the Auschwitz archives they discover unpublished witness statements by tailors in Block 1 And completely unexpectedly they also discover a cousin of Ide's living in Florida She had survived as a child by hiding in an attic in Brussels and speaks for the first time about those dark days It took the authors a year to wind their questing way through important discoveries and setbacks but in this tribute an unknown piece of history has finally been given a face
