<u>Food in Wartime</u> Arthur Williams, When Britain declared war on Germany on September 3 1939 housewives across the nation faced an immediate and unprecedented challenge that would define their daily existence for the next six years The government having learned harsh lessons from the Great War s food shortages implemented a comprehensive rationing
