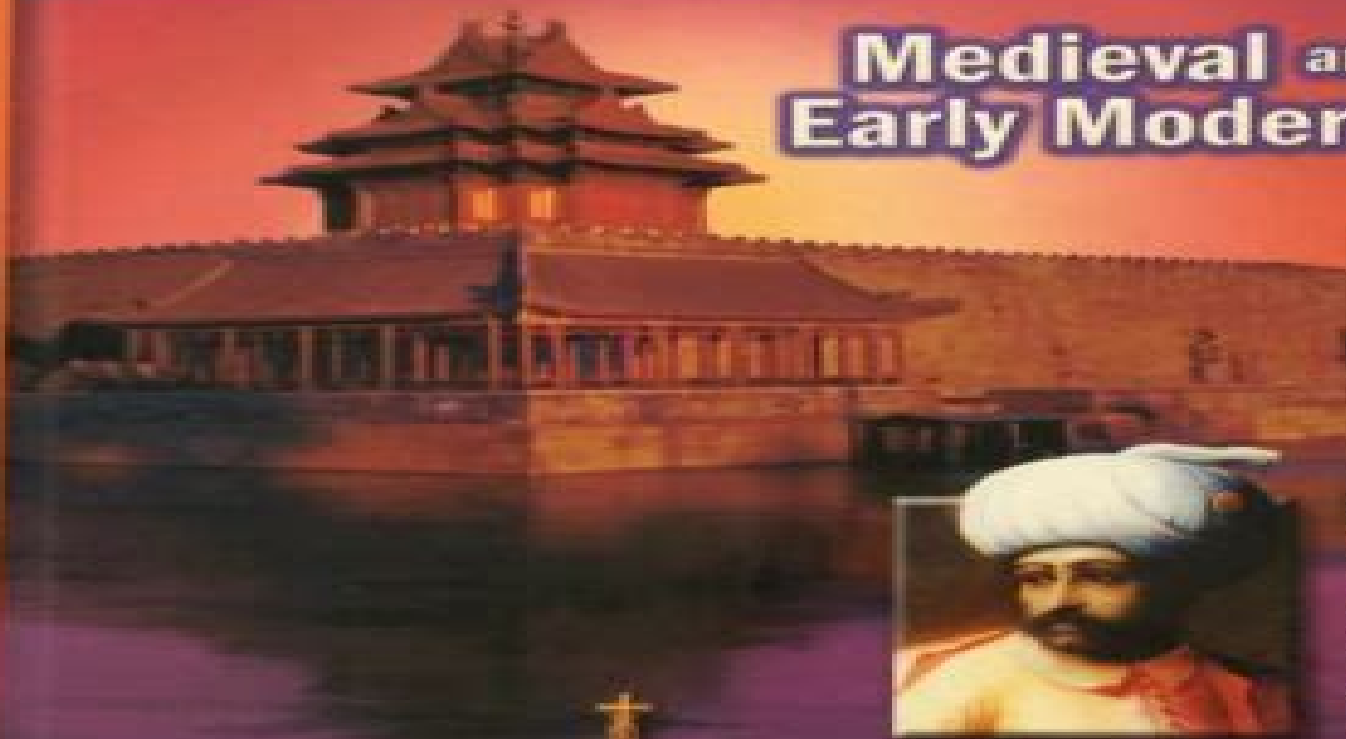

relative autonomy of those laborers as well as the likelihood they would achieve freedom As plantation production for export purposes emerged as the most dynamic sector of Cuba s economy by 1810 the Atlantic networks used to obtain enslaved workers showed increasing strain British abolitionism exerted additional pressure on the slave trade To offset the loss of access to enslaved laborers colonial officials expanded the state s authority to sentence deserters vagrants and fugitives both enslaved and free to labor in public works such as civil construction road building and the creation of Havana s defensive forts State efforts in this area demonstrate the deep roots of state enslavement and forced labor in nineteenth century Spanish colonialism and in capitalist development in the Atlantic world Constructing the Spanish Empire in Havana places the processes of building and sustaining the Spanish empire in the imperial hub of Havana in a comparative perspective with other sites of empire building in the Atlantic world Furthermore it considers the human costs of reproducing the Spanish empire in a major Caribbean port the state s role in shaping the institution of slavery and the experiences of enslaved and other coerced laborers both before and after the beginning of Cuba s sugar boom in the early nineteenth century
