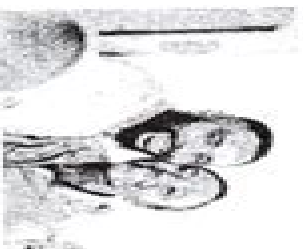
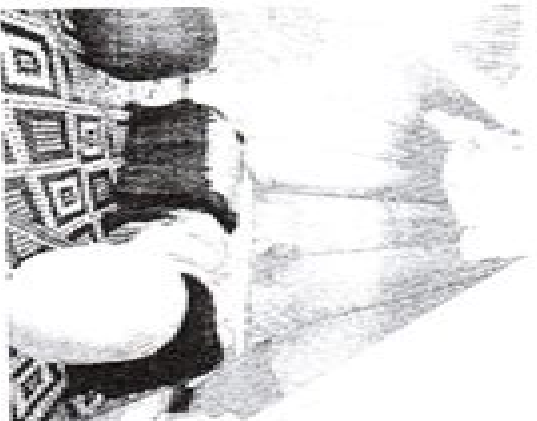
- They have been given two tourist options (Annexure A). You will need to help them make a choice based on their profile and the duration of their trip.
