# Middle Colonies Timeline



The Great Migration, the mass migration of shousands of English people to the Americas shat took place between 1630 and 1640. New Jersey was settled. The Duke of York provided some land to Sir George Carteret and Lord John Berkeley who named their colony New Jersey. Here they provided freedom of religion and land. The two parts of the colony were not united into a royal colony until 1702.



Jacob Leisler (1640-1691) was a German immigrant who led the insurrection against local colonial officials from 1689 to 1691 in colonial New York.



The Duke of York gained New Netherland and New Sweden which had been founded by Peter Minuit. He renamed the whole region Delaware. This area was a part of Pennsylvania until 1703 when Delaware created its own legislature.
