Handbook of Autobiography / Autofiction Martina Wagner-Egelhaaf, 2019-01-29 Autobiographical writings have been a major cultural genre from antiquity to the present time General questions of the literary as e g the relation between literature and reality truth and fiction the dependency of author narrator and figure or issues of individual and cultural styles etc can be studied preeminently in the autobiographical genre Yet the tradition of life writing has in the course of literary history developed manifold types and forms Especially in the globalized age where the media and other technological cultural factors contribute to a rapid transformation of lifestyles autobiographical writing has maintained even enhanced its popularity and importance By conceiving autobiography in a wide sense that includes memoirs diaries self portraits and autofiction as well as media transformations of the genre this three volume handbook offers a comprehensive survey of theoretical approaches systematic aspects and historical developments in an international and interdisciplinary perspective While autobiography is usually considered to be a European tradition special emphasis is placed on the modes of self representation in non Western cultures and on inter and transcultural perspectives of the genre The individual contributions are closely interconnected by a system of cross references The handbook addresses scholars of cultural and literary studies students as well as non academic readers

Autobiographical Inscriptions Barbara Ruth Rodriguez, 1999 As life writing began to attract critical attention in the 1950s and 60s theorists critics and practitioners of autobiography concerned themselves with inscribing that is establishing or asserting a set of conventions that would define constructions of identity and acts of self representation More recently however scholars have identified the ways in which autobiographical works recognize and resist those conventions Moving beyond the narrow prescriptive definition of autobiography as the factual chronological first person narrative of the life story critics have theorized the genre from postmodern and feminist perspectives Autobiographical Inscriptions contributes a theory of autobiography by women writers of color to this lively repositioning of identity studies Barbara Rodriguez breaks new ground in the field with a discussion of the ways in which innovations of form and structure bolster the arguments for personhood articulated by Harriet Jacobs Zora Neale Hurston Hisaye Yamamoto Maxine Hong Kingston Leslie Marmon Silko Adrienne Kennedy and Cecile Pineda Rodriguez maps the intersections of form and structure with issues of race and gender in these women s works Central to the autobiographical act and to the representation of the self in language these intersections mark the ways in which the American woman writer of color comments on the process of subject construction as she produces original forms for the life story In each chapter Rodriguez pairs canonized texts with less well known works reading autobiographical works across cultural contexts and historical periods and even across artistic media By raising crucial questions about structure Autobiographical Inscriptions analyzes the ways in which these texts also destabilize notions of race and gender The result is a remarkable analysis of the seemingly endless range of formal strategies available to adopted and adapted by the American woman writer of color

Autobiographical Writing and British Literature 1783-1834 James Treadwell, 2005-01-20 The word autobiography is a late eighteenth century coinage yet by 1826 it was used as the title for a multi volume anthology of self writing and in 1834 Thomas Carlyle wrote of these Autobiographical times of ours Over the course of those few decades readers and writers came to recognize and name a new genre This book is the first full study of the phenomenon examining both the conditions and the practice of autobiographical writing in Romantic literature Historians of autobiography have often pointed to the turn of the nineteenth century as a pivotal moment In Rousseau and De Quincey's Confessions Wordsworth's Prelude and other canonical documents it has been argued self writing begins to serve the purpose of expressing the individuality autonomy and interiority of the self A more wide ranging view of the actual state of autobiography at the time exposes this narrative as a misrepresentation Self writing does gain a new kind of prominence around 1800 not however because it articulates Romantic ideologies of selfhood but because it becomes a focus of scrutiny and of contention The decades of the Romantic period identified themselves as Autobiographical times but did so anxiously This book asks what forms did that recognition and that anxiety take within the literary culture of the period What did autobiography mean to Romantic readers and writers How do autobiographical texts of the period reflect express and negotiate these conditions As well as reading a wide variety of those documents with single chapters devoted to works by Coleridge Byron and Lamb Treadwell examines writing on and around autobiography essays reviews and other forms of commentary By preserving a continuous relation between the texts and their contexts this book offers the first proper study of what is actually meant by Romantic autobiography

Lark Hall, 2017-09-29 H Lark Hall presents the first comprehensive biography of Vernon Louis Parrington 1871 1929 The recipient of the 1928 Pulitzer Prize in history for the first two volumes of his Main Currents in American Thought Parrington remains one of the most influential literary and historical scholars of the early twentieth century Parrington was a man in search of a personal myth He found his self image successively mirrored in Victorian novels painting poetry populism religion the arts and crafts movement American literature and American history These changes were also reflected in his teaching as a professor of English at the College of Emporia the University of Oklahoma and the University of Washington Published late in his career the two volumes of Main Currents represented the culmination of his search Drawing upon his personal papers including correspondence diaries and student course work Main Currents chapter drafts and other unpublished writings Hall traces Parrington's intellectual development from his Midwestern childhood through his mid life engagement with English poet and artist William Morris then from the radical impact of the new history to the tempered post World War One reflection of his career at the University of Washington Hall's reinterpretation of Main Currents emphasizes Parrington's concern with the drama of the life of the mind and links his historical viewpoint to his own personal history **The Analytical Writer**

Gideon Smales, 1867 **Literary Impostors** Rosmarin Heidenreich, 2018-07-30 In the first half of the twentieth century a number of Canadian authors were revealed to have faked the identities that made them famous What is extraordinary about these writers is that they actually became in everyday life characters they had themselves invented Many of their works were simultaneously fictional and autobiographical reflecting the duality of their identities In *Literary Impostors* Rosmarin Heidenreich tells the intriguing stories both the true and the fabricated versions of six Canadian authors who obliterated their pasts and re-invented themselves Grey Owl was in fact an Englishman named Archie Belaney Will James the cowboy writer from the American West was the Quebec born francophone Ernest Dufault the prairie novelist Frederick Philip Grove turned out to be the German writer and translator Felix Paul Greve Chief Buffalo Child Long Lance Onoto Watanna and Sui Sin Far were the chosen identities of three mixed race writers whose given names were respectively Sylvester Long Winnifred Eaton and Edith Eaton Heidenreich argues that their imposture in some cases not discovered until long after their deaths was not fraudulent in the usual sense these writers forged new identities to become who they felt they really were In an age of proliferating cyber identities and controversial claims to ancestry *Literary Impostors* raises timely questions involving race migrancy and gender to illustrate the porousness of the line that is often drawn between an author's biography

and the fiction he or she produces **D. H. Lawrence: Late Essays and Articles** D. H. Lawrence, 2004-04 In his last years D H Lawrence often wrote for newspapers he needed the money and clearly enjoyed the work He also wrote several substantial essays during the same period This meticulously edited collection brings together major essays such as Pornography and Obscenity and Lawrence s spirited Introduction to the volume of his Paintings a group of autobiographical pieces two of which are published here for the first time and the articles Lawrence wrote at the invitation of newspaper and magazine editors There are thirty nine items in total thirty five of them deriving from original manuscripts all were written between 1926 and Lawrence s death in March 1930 They are ordered chronologically according to the date of composition each is preceded by an account of the circumstances in which it came to be published The volume is introduced by a substantial survey of Lawrence s career as a writer responding directly to public interests and concerns

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
