Sonora Its Geographical Personality Robert C West:

Sonora Robert C. names of the purchasers often identified as Godfather Stockel also explores Jesuit and Franciscan attempts to maintain their missions on New Spain's northern frontier during the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries She focuses on how international political and economic forces shaped the determination of the priests to mold the Apaches into Christians and tax paying citizens of the Empire Diseases warfare interpersonal relations and an overwhelming number of surrendered Chiricahuas at the missions along with reduced supplies from Mexico City forced the missionaries to use every means to continue their efforts at conversion including deporting the Apaches to Cuba and selling others to Christian families on the colonial frontier
