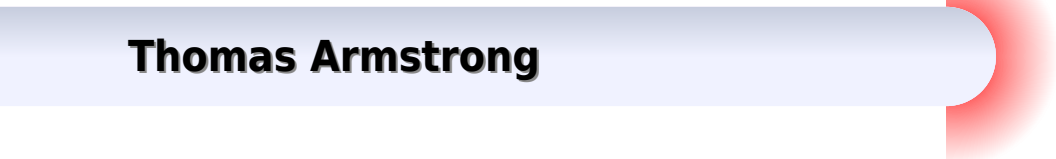

conceptual worlds as the site of worthy Ethiopia as well as in the wider context of discourses of ethnicity and race
