Liebling, Stafford associated with many of the major literary figures of her day, including the Southern Fugitives, the New York intellectual coterie, and writers for the New Yorker to which she regularly contributed short stories. Goodman also describes Stafford's sustaining friendships with other women writers such as Evelyn Scott and Caroline Gordon and with her New Yorker editor Katharine S. White. This highly readable biography will appeal to a wide audience interested in twentieth-century literature and the writing of women's lives.
