When you give a negative remark incise your voice/ or put down a student, remind yourself that you now owe that child 5 positives to regain buy-in from him/her.

-Now take out a journal or writing paper. Reflect on these private and personal journal questions:

Would you want to be in your classroom?

If you could be a student in any other person on our team's classroom who would it be and why? Schedule an observation in their room.

Reflect on the noise level of your room. Is it loud, why is that? Because of you, your students, or your influence to make it scothing? What comes first the chicken or the egg? Do you think you've ever inadvertently found yourself engaged in a noise war with your class.

What makes a soothing classroom, how can you do one thing next week to make your environment more soothing?
