They are most effective when not directly targeting forests due to their heterogeneity but central damaging factors. With regard to the dominant regulatory and subsidy based governance for forests, we show that it remains necessary to supplement these quantity governance systems with certain easily graspable and thus controllable regulatory and subsidy regulations such as a regulatory protection of old growth forests with almost no exceptions, extension of the livestock to land ratio established in organic farming to all farming, far reaching restriction of bioenergy use to certain residues flanked by import bans and a national and international complete conversion of all agricultural and forest subsidies to public money for public services to promote nature conservation and afforestation in addition to the quantity control systems.
