lobbied to create professional opportunities for themselves and some went so far as to create a union that endorsed preferential treatment for French nationals As France became more ethnically and religiously diverse due immigration from Africa Asia and the Caribbean French jazz critics and fans noted the insidious appearance of racism in their own country and had to contend with how their own citizens would address the changing demographics of the nation even if they continued to insist that racism was more prevalent in the United States As independence movements brought an end to the French empire jazz enthusiasts from both former colonies and France had to reenvision their relationship to jazz and to the music s international audiences In these postwar decades the French were working to preserve a distinct national identity in the face of weakened global authority most forcefully represented by decolonization and American hegemony Through this originally African American music French listeners commentators and musicians participated in a process that both challenged and reinforced ideas about their own culture and nation
