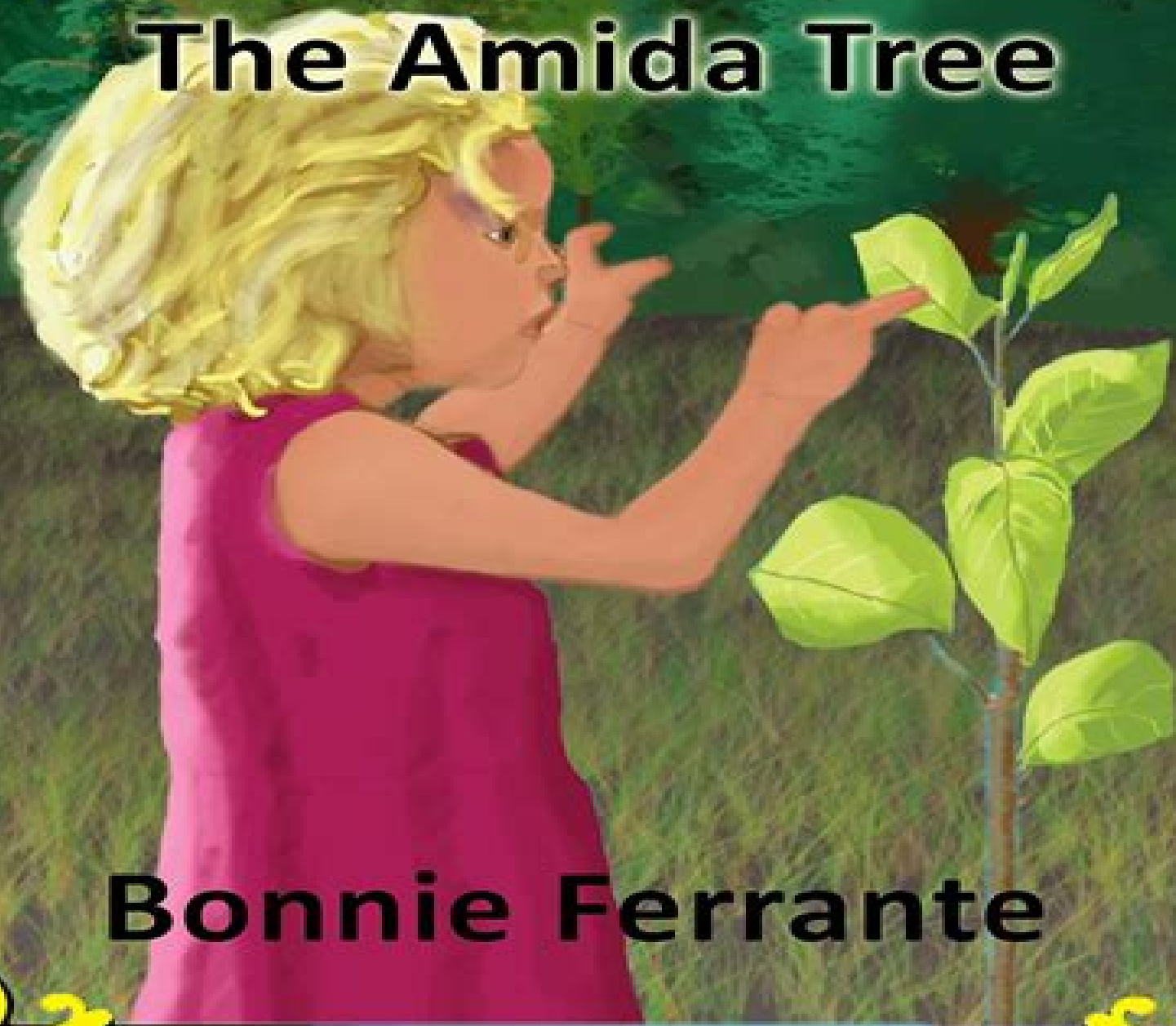

Tappenden, Tamás Biró, 2019-06-13 What role do texts play in religious practice What is the relationship between these texts and cognition Are some texts more successful because they are better adapted to our cognitive structures Why is biblical interpretation necessary and what is the cognitive process behind it This book considers such questions and fills the gap in research on religious texts and narratives in the cognitive science of religion The study of ancient religions and biblical studies are dominated by textual evidence However the cognitive science of religion is lacking significant research on the language and textual interpretation of this literature This book presents a systematic attempt to redefine the interpretation of religious texts in a cognitive framework providing concrete textual analysis on a broad selection of biblical passages It explores the ways that cognitive approaches to language and textual interpretation expand the disciplines of the cognitive science of religion and biblical studies This book brings together methodology from the cognitive sciences linguistics philology biblical studies and religious studies to offer a new perspective for biblical studies and cognitive sciences It presents a renewed vision of textual interpretation one that aligns hermeneutical reflection with our cognitive capacities The Face of Jizo Hank Glassman, 2012-01-31 Farther on I find other figures of Jizo single reliefs sculptured upon tombs But one of these is a work of art so charming that I feel a pain at being obliged to pass it by More sweet assuredly than any imaged Christ this dream in white stone of the playfellow of dead children like a beautiful young boy with gracious eyelids half closed and face made heavenly by such a smile as only Buddhist art could have imagined the smile of infinite lovingness and supremest gentleness Indeed so charming the ideal of Jizo is that in the speech of the people a beautiful face is always likened to his Jizo kao as the face of Jizo Lafcadio Hearn Glimpses of an Unfamiliar Japan 1894 Stone images of the Buddhist deity Jizo bedecked in a red cloth bib and presiding over offerings of flowers coins candles and incense are a familiar sight throughout Japan Known in China as a savior from hell s torment Jizo in Japan came to be utterly transformed through fusion with the local tradition of kami worship and ancient fertility cults In particular the Jizo cult became associated with gods of borders or transitions the stone gods known as dosojin Although the study of Jizo is often relegated to the folkloric Hank Glassman in this highly original and readable book demonstrates that the bodhisattva s cult was promoted and embraced at the most elite levels of society The Face of Jizo explores the stories behind sculptural and

painted images of Jizo to reveal a fascinating cultural history Employing the methodologies of the early twentieth century renegade art historian Aby Warburg Glassman s focus on the visual culture of medieval Japanese religion is not concerned with the surface form or iconographical lineages of Jizo s images but with the social ritual and narrative contexts that bring the icons to life He skillfully weaves together many elements of the Jizo cult doctrine ritual cosmology iconography to animate the images he examines Thus The Face of Jizo is truly a work of iconology in the Warburgian sense Glassman s choice to examine the cult of Jizo through the medium of the icon makes for a most engaging and approachable history of this most Japanese of Buddhist deities

The Death of Sacred Texts Kristina Myrvold, 2016-03-09 The Death of Sacred Texts draws attention to a much neglected topic in the study of sacred texts the religious and ritual attitudes towards texts which have become old and damaged and can no longer be used for reading practices or in religious worship This book approaches religious texts and scriptures by focusing on their physical properties and the dynamic interactions of devices and habits that lie beneath and within a given text In the last decades a growing body of research studies has directed attention to the multiple uses and ways people encounter written texts and how they make them alive even as social actors in different times and cultures Considering religious people seem to have all the motives for giving their sacred texts a respectful symbolic treatment scholars have paid surprisingly little attention to the ritual procedures of disposing and renovating old texts This book fills this gap providing empirical data and theoretical analyses of historical and contemporary religious attitudes towards and practices of text disposals within seven world religions Judaism Islam Christianity Hinduism Buddhism Jainism and Sikhism Exploring the cultural and historical variations of rituals for religious scriptures and texts such as burials cremations and immersion into rivers and the underlying beliefs within the religious traditions this book investigates how these religious practices and stances respond to modernization and globalization processes when new technologies have made it possible to mass produce and publish religious texts on the Internet

"Rise, Ye Sea Slugs!" Robin D Gill, 2003 Rise Ye Sea Slugs is a book of many faces First it is a book of translated haiku and contains over 900 of these short Japanese poems in the original smoothly inserted in the main body with phonetic and literal renditions as well as the authors English translations and explanations All but a dozen or two of the haiku are translated for the first time There is an index of poets poems and a bibliography Second it is a book of sea slug haiku for all of the poems are about holothurians which scientists prefer to call sea cucumbers The word cucumber is long for haiku and metaphorically unsuitable for many poems so poetic license was taken With this book the namako as the sea cucumber is called in Japanese becomes the most translated single subject in haiku surpassing the harvest moon the snow the cuckoo butterflies and even cherry blossoms Third it is a book of original haiku While the authors original intent was to include only genuine old haiku dating back to the 17th century modern haiku were added and eventually Keigu Gills haiku name composed about a hundred of his own to help fill out gaps in the metaphorical museum For many if not most modern haiku taken from the web it is also their first time in print Fourth it is a

book of metaphor How may we arrange hundreds of poems on a single theme Gill divides them into 21 main metaphors including the Cold Sea Slug the Mystic Sea Slug the Helpless Sea Slug the Slippery Sea Slug the Silent Sea Slug and the Melancholy Sea Slug giving each a chapter within which the metaphors may be further subdivided and adds a 100 pages of Sundry Sea Slugs scores of varieties including Monster Spam Flying Urban Myth and Exploding Fifth it is a book on haiku Editors usually select only the best haiku but Gill includes good and bad haiku by everyone from the 17th century haiku master to the anonymous haiku rejected in some internet contest This is not to say all poems found were included but that the standard was along more taxonomic or encyclopedic lines poems that filled in a metaphorical or sub metaphorical gap were always welcome Also Gill shows there is more than one type of good haiku These are new ways to approach haiku Sixth it is a book on translation There are approximately 2 translations per haiku and some boast a dozen These are arranged in mixed single double and triple column clusters which make each reading seem a different aspect of a singular almost crystalline whole The authors aim is to demonstrate that multiple reading such as found in Hofstadter's *Le Ton Beau de Marot* is not only a fun game but a bona fide method of translating especially useful for translating poetry between exotic tongues Seventh it is a book of nature writing natural history or metaphysics in the Emersonian sense Gill tried to compile relevant or interesting not necessarily both historical this includes the sea slug in literature English or Japanese and in folklore and scientific facts to read haiku in their light or conversely bring out science from haiku Unlike most nature writers Gill admits to doing no fieldwork but sluggishly staying put and relying upon reports from more mobile souls Eighth it is a book about food symbolism The sea cucumber is noticed by Japanese because they eat it the eating itself involves physical difficulties slipperiness and hardness and pleasures from overcoming them It is also identified with a state of mind where you are what you eat takes on psychological dimensions not found in the food literature of the West Ninth it is a book about Japanese culture Gill does not set out to explain Japan and the sea slug itself is silent but the collection of poems and their explanations which include analysis by poets who responded to the author's questions as well as historical sources take us all around the culture from ancient myths to contemporary dreams Tenth it is a book about sea cucumbers While most species of sea cucumbers are not mentioned and the coverage of the Japanese sea cucumber is sketchy from the scientific point of view Gill does introduce this animal graced to live with no brain thanks to the smart materials comprising it and blessed for sucking in dirty sediment and pooping it out clean Eleventh it is a book about ambiguity Gill admits there is much that cannot be translated much he cannot know and much to be improved in future editions for which purpose he advises readers to see the on line Glosses and Errata in English and Japanese His policy is to confide in rather than slip by the reader unnoticed in the manner of the invisible modern translator and allow the reader to make choices or choose to allow multiple possibilities to exist by not choosing Twelfth the book is the first of dozens of spin offs from a twenty book haiku *sajiki* poetic almanac called *In Praise of Olde Haiku IPOOH* for short Gill hopes to finish within the decade Thirteenth The book is a novelty item It has a

different often witty header caption on top of each page and copious notes that are rarely academic and often humorous

Dictionary of Buddhism Soka Gakkai,2009-01-01 Anyone reading English translations of Buddhist texts will encounter a host of names terms and phrases whose meanings are not clear even though they appear in English Buddhism is famous for its specialized terminology and translation alone may not communicate its full meaning East Asian Buddhist diction is layered with several languages Pali Sanskrit Chinese and Japanese and the only way to make one s way through this linguistic maze without getting lost is with the aid of a good dictionary The Soka Gakkai Dictionary of Buddhism a revised and expanded version of A Dictionary of Buddhist Terms and Concepts 1983 is a welcome addition that serves this purpose Written clearly for the general reader the Dictionary contains over 2 700 entries While it is designed primarily for use with the Soka Gakkai s translations of Nichiren s works the Dictionary contains a wealth of terms found in all other traditions of Buddhism Definitions are given for technical terms historical figures doctrinal texts institutions and place names The entries provide complete cross references so that readers may know and further pursue meanings of term equivalents as rendered in other ways or languages Ten appendixes provide maps and word lists that enable the reader to find terms in English Pali Sanskrit Chinese or Japanese Like all Buddhist masters Nichiren presented his particular message in the wider context of other Buddhist teachings and practices To know the particular one must also understand the general context and the Dictionary in addressing both levels provides essential knowledge not only for students of Nichiren Buddhism but for anyone reading Buddhist texts

Selected Works of D.T. Suzuki, Volume II Daisetsu Teitaro Suzuki,2015-01-15 Daisetsu Teitaro Suzuki was a key figure in the introduction of Buddhism to the non Asian world Many outside Japan encountered Buddhism for the first time through his writings and teaching and for nearly a century his work and legacy have contributed to the ongoing religious and cultural interchange between Japan and the rest of the world particularly the United States and Europe This second volume of Selected Works of D T Suzuki brings together Suzuki s writings on Pure Land Buddhism At the center of the Pure Land tradition is the Buddha Amida and his miraculous realm known as paradise or the land of bliss where sentient beings should aspire to be born in their next life and where liberation and enlightenment are

Since Meiji J.
