from the fields of experimenter bias hypnosis and placebo medicine psychotherapy casework and counselling research is reviewed and related to the model and the relationship between this analysis and labelling theory is discussed The book demonstrates that it is the behaviour of the worker towards the client which is of crucial importance and proposes that the client's future and his or her personal strengths should be an important focus of the helping relationship Finally it outlines the dangers of negative expectations and emphasises the ways in which expectations can be used to optimum effect
