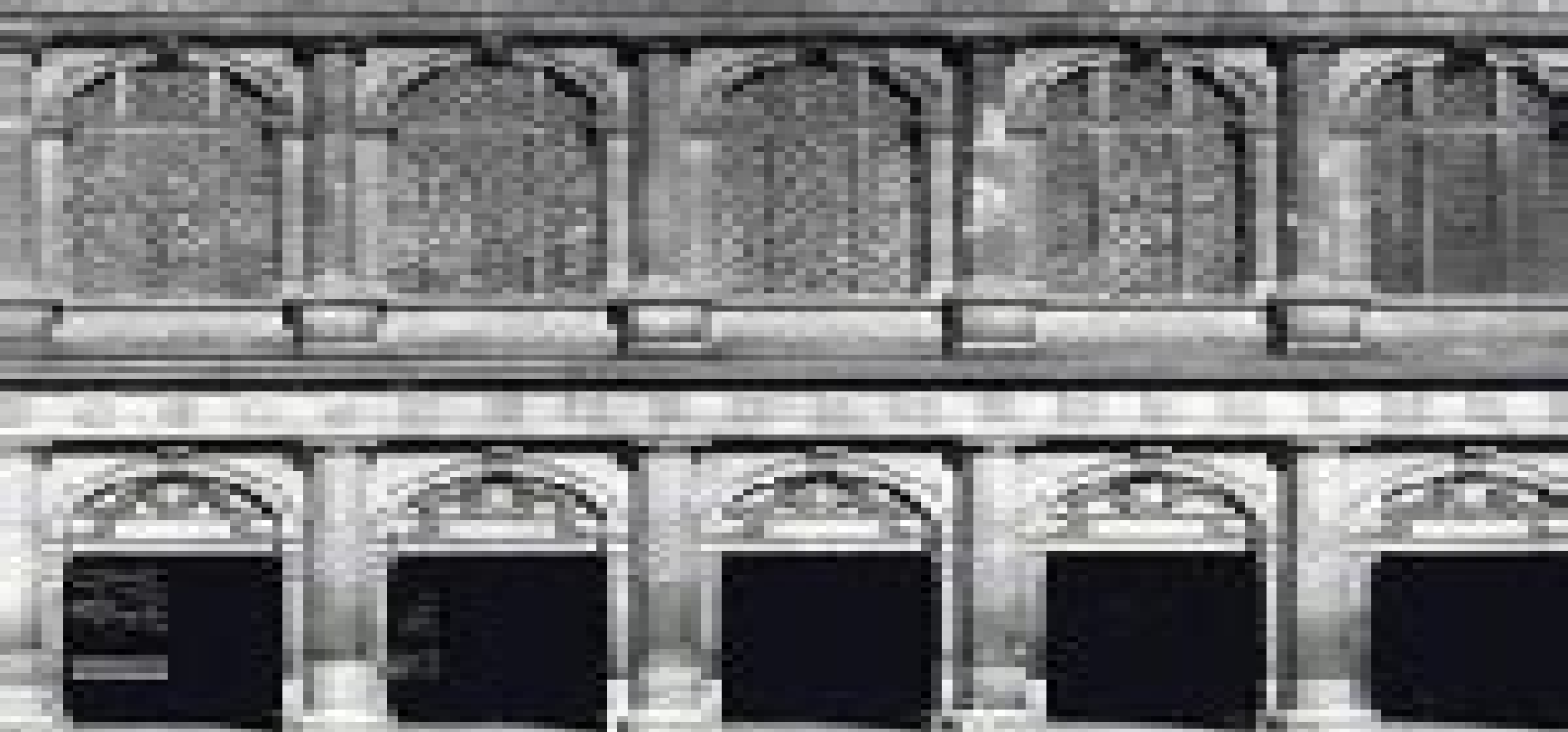

of social formation when Britain was forging the nation Linda Colley they were wielded alike by Whigs and Tories the aristocracy and the commercial middle classes high class artists and grub street writers They were most persuasive however when used jointly portrait prints ideally accompanied by Brief Lives sold by the thousands National histories were re issued to include pictures Portraitists were required to stage their sitters as though taken from real life situations Embedded into such interplay between texts and images was an aesthetic claim doing biography was a multimedia enterprise Far from being just words on a page eighteenth century life writing came with frontispiece portraits illustrations or elaborate title pages Biographers directed their readers to existing portraits of their subjects to enhance the reading experience Portraits made of calligraphic writing blurred the boundaries between text and image As a thorough reassessment of visual culture s role in producing biographies this book offers an in depth analysis of the rhetorics of portraiture and life writing an historical account of their sister arts tradition and an inquiry into the social function of profiling people

Book Ownership in Stuart England David Pearson, 2021-01-26 This volume provides a wide ranging account of the development and importance of private libraries and book ownership through the seventeenth century based upon many kinds of evidence including examination of thousands of books and a list of over 1 300 known owners from diverse backgrounds It considers questions of evolution contents and size and motives for book ownership during a century when growing markets for both new and second hand books meant that books would be found in varying numbers in the homes of all kinds of people from the humble to the wealthy Book ownership by women and by non professional households is explicitly explored Other topics include the balance of motivation between books for use or for display the relationship between libraries and museums and cultures of collecting While presenting a wealth of information in this field conveniently brought together this volume also advances methodologies for book history and makes extensive use of material evidence such as bookbindings It challenges received wisdom around priorities for studying private libraries and the terminology which is appropriate to use In addition the list of owners detailed in the Appendix make this book a work of permanent reference alongside its value in advancing book history

Architects and Intellectual Culture in Post-Restoration England Matthew Walker, 2017-10-13 Architects Builders and Intellectual Culture in Restoration England charts the moment when well educated well resourced English intellectuals first became interested in classical architecture in substantial numbers This occurred after the Restoration of the Monarchy in 1660 and involved people such as John Evelyn Robert Hooke Sir Christopher Wren and Roger North Matthew Walker explores how these figures treated architecture as a subject of intellectual enquiry either as writers as designers of buildings or as both In four substantial chapters it looks at how the architect was defined as a major intellectual figure how architects acquired material that allowed them to define themselves as intellectually competent architects how intellectual writers in the period handled knowledge of ancient architecture in their writing and how the design process in architecture was conceived of in theoretical writing at the time In all Walker shows that the key to understanding English architectural culture at the time is to understand how architecture was handled as knowledge and how architects were conceived of as collectors and producers of such knowledge He also makes the claim that architecture was treated as an extremely serious and important area of intellectual enquiry the result of which was that by the turn of the eighteenth

century architects and architectural writers could count themselves amongst England's intellectual and cultural elite

A History of the University of Cambridge: Volume 2, 1546-1750 Victor Morgan, Damian Riehl Leader, Peter Searby, 1988 This volume brings to completion the four volume A History of the University of Cambridge and is a vital contribution to the history not only of one major university but of the academic societies of early modern Europe in general Its main author Victor Morgan has made a special study of the relations between Cambridge and its wider world the court and church hierarchy which sought to control it in the aftermath of the Reformation the country that is the provincial gentry and the wider academic world Morgan also finds the seeds of contemporary problems of university governance in the struggles which led to and followed the new Elizabethan Statutes of 1570 Christopher Brooke General Editor and part author has contributed chapters on architectural history and among other themes a study of the intellectual giants of the late seventeenth and early eighteenth centuries

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
