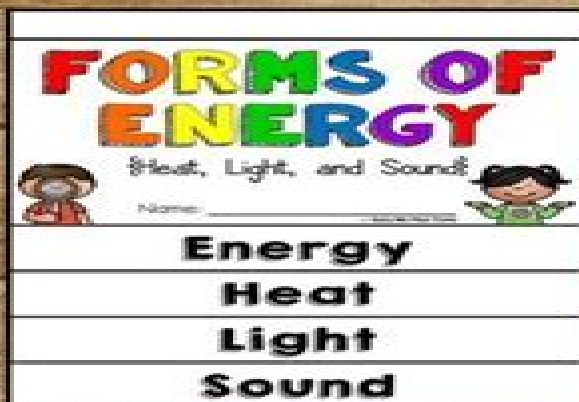

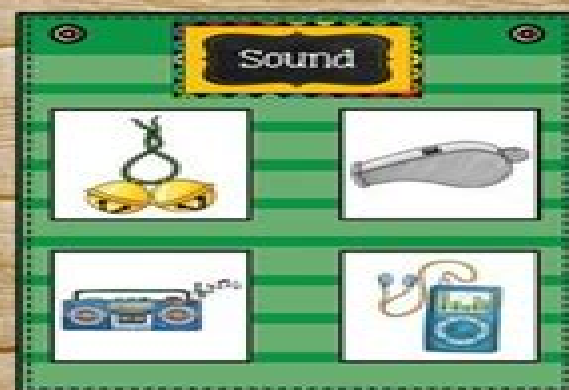
Now, put one M & M in an open hand and the other in a closed hand. Keep it there for 2 minutes. Observe what happens.
