This transformation is often ideological as well as historical or biographical. Evans concludes that the narrative reversals in Milton's poetry suggest his constant attempts to bring about an intellectual revolution that, at a time of religious and political change in England, would transform an age.

Border States in the Work of Tom Mac Intyre Catriona Ryan, 2012-01-17. This work analyses the prose and drama of the Irish writer Tom Mac Intyre and the concept of paleo postmodernism.
