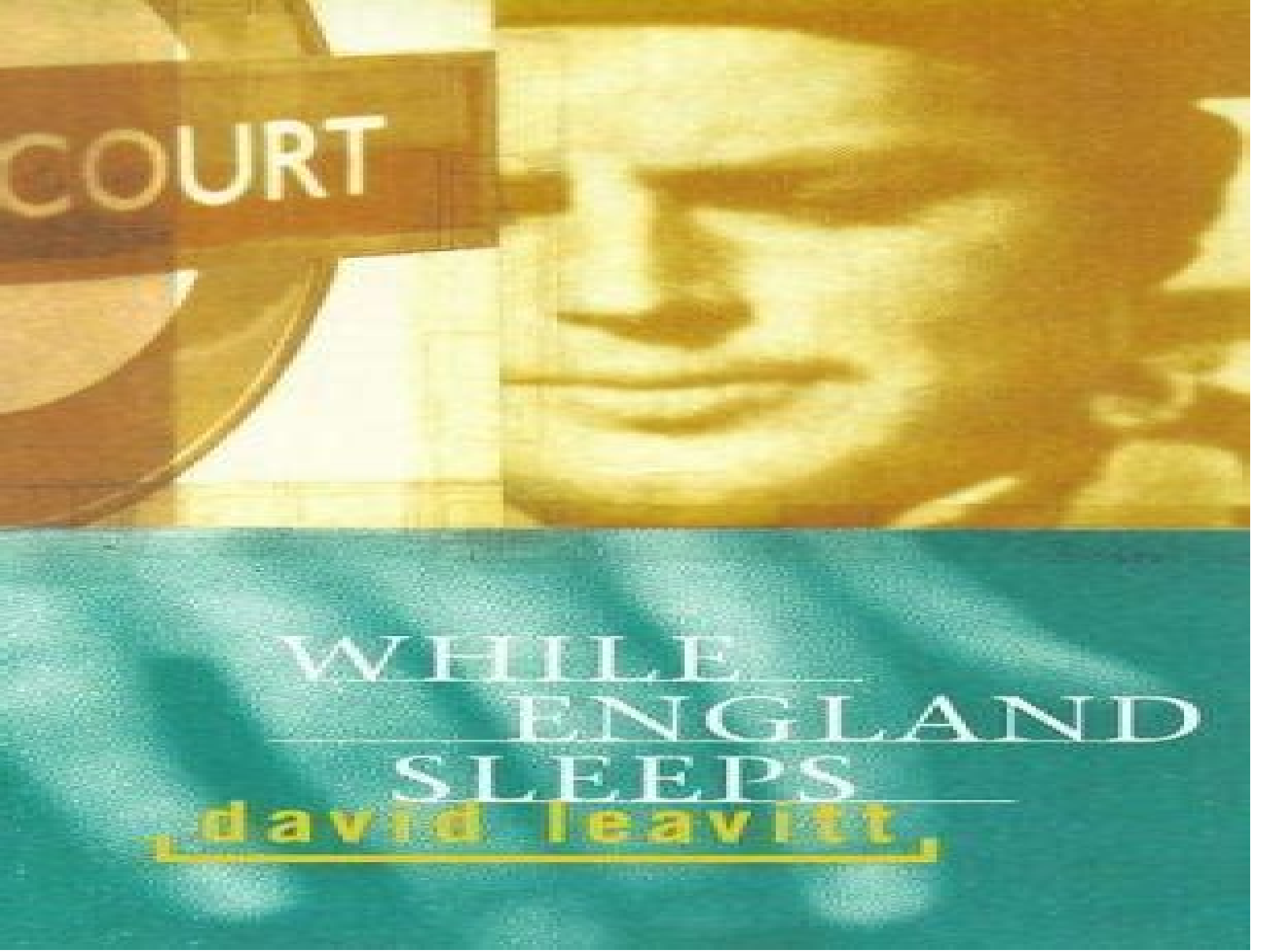

While England Sleeps David Leavitt, 1993 Leavitt has earned high praise for his empathetic portrayal of human sexuality and the complexities of intimate relationships In *While England Sleeps* available for the first time in two years he moves beyond precisely controlled domestic drama to create a historical novel set against the rise of fascism in 1930s Europe that tells a story of love and the violent chaos of war

queer existence These include secrets relating to the closet and AIDS homosexual panic lesbian social invisibility transgender subjectivity the intersection between sexuality and race the vilification of the queer subject as monstrous Other the domestic life of the gay couple destabilised by homophobic influences from the public world and the heterosexual family disrupted by homosexual secrets from within The queer recasting of gothic motifs such as the haunted house the uncanny city the grotesque body and the breakdown of the family due to paternal incest receives attention

New Selected Journals, 1939-1995 Stephen Spender, 2012-07-03 Private faces in public places Are wiser and nicer Than public faces in private places W H Auden dedication to Stephen Spender 1932 Stephen Spender wrote almost a million words of journal entries between his September Journal in 1939 and his death in 1995 In choosing from these voluminous journals for the new edition the editors have tried to provide a picture of the various lives Spender brought together in autobiographical form The earlier 1985 edition of the Journals was overseen by the author and it privileged his thoughts about poetry his own and other people s The new edition includes the final ten years of Spender s life and provides access to the more intimate thoughts and feelings of the private man but equally documents his life as a public intellectual who played a part in shaping the European literary and intellectual culture of his age As we look back on the dramatic events of the twentieth century we find that Spender was involved in many of them the reconstruction of Germany and the construction of Europe as Unesco s first Literary Councillor the development of the cultural Cold War as editor of Encounter the founding of Israel the anti Vietnam movement in America The Journals provide a personal version of sixty turbulent years of the twentieth century hovering between diary autobiography and history

Kruger, 2013-10-28 This is the first book length study of the rich fiction that has emerged from the AIDS crisis Examining first the ways in which scientific discourse on AIDS has reflected ideologies of gender and sexuality such as the construction of AIDS as a disease of gay men part of a battle over masculinity and thus largely excluding women with AIDS from public attention the book considers how such discourses have shaped narrative understandings of AIDS On the one hand AIDS is seen as an invariably fatal weakening of an individual s bodily defenses a depiction often used to reconfirm an identification between disease and a weak and vulnerable gayness On the other hand AIDS is understood in terms of an epidemic attributable to gay immorality or unnaturalness The fiction of AIDS depends upon these two narratives with one major subgenre of AIDS novel presenting narratives of personal illness decline and death and a second focusing on epidemic spread These novels also question the narrative structures upon which they depend intervening particularly against the homophobia of those structures though also sometimes reinforcing it
