African Traditional Medicine (ATM) has a long history dating back thousands of years and has resulted in a wealth of therapeutic agents from plants and animals used in the treatment of diseases. Most of the associated knowledge about these medicines has been passed down from generation to generation via oral folklore. However, as a result of westernization and globalization and the loss of natural habitats and biodiversity, as well as the loss of oral traditions, the empirical knowledge associated with medicinal substances is at a risk of being lost forever. A great deal of related research has been done and published in academic, doctorate, and master's theses, most of which are available only as hard copies at the respective universities in herbal texts and journals. Most of these works have not been published and made available to the international community. It is well acknowledged that the origin of many drugs can be traced back to natural sources, for example, artemisinin, ephedrine, tubocurarine, digoxin, reserpine. Some popular herbal medicines have their origin in African plants, for example, Umckaloabo (EPs 7630), a standardized proprietary extract of *Perlagonium sidoides* used in some over-the-counter medicines for upper respiratory infections. Other African plants have also offered medicines and/or healthcare products and pharmacologically active compounds, e.g., *Prunus africana* bark extracts for the management of prostate and lower urinary tract symptoms (LUTS), yohimbe from *Pausinystalia johimbe* or Bitter Aloe or Cape Aloe, *Aloe ferox*.
