

Medication Administration Study Guide

The proper technique for subcutaneous injections involves the use of a ½-inch needle, 23- to 25-gauge, at a 45- to 90-degree angle of insertion, dependent on patient size. A 1- to the 1½-inch needle is used for intramuscular injection. Aspiration is done with all medications except anticoagulants and insulin. The landmark for the vastus lateralis is one handbreadth below the greater trochanter and above the knee on the outer aspect of the thigh.
