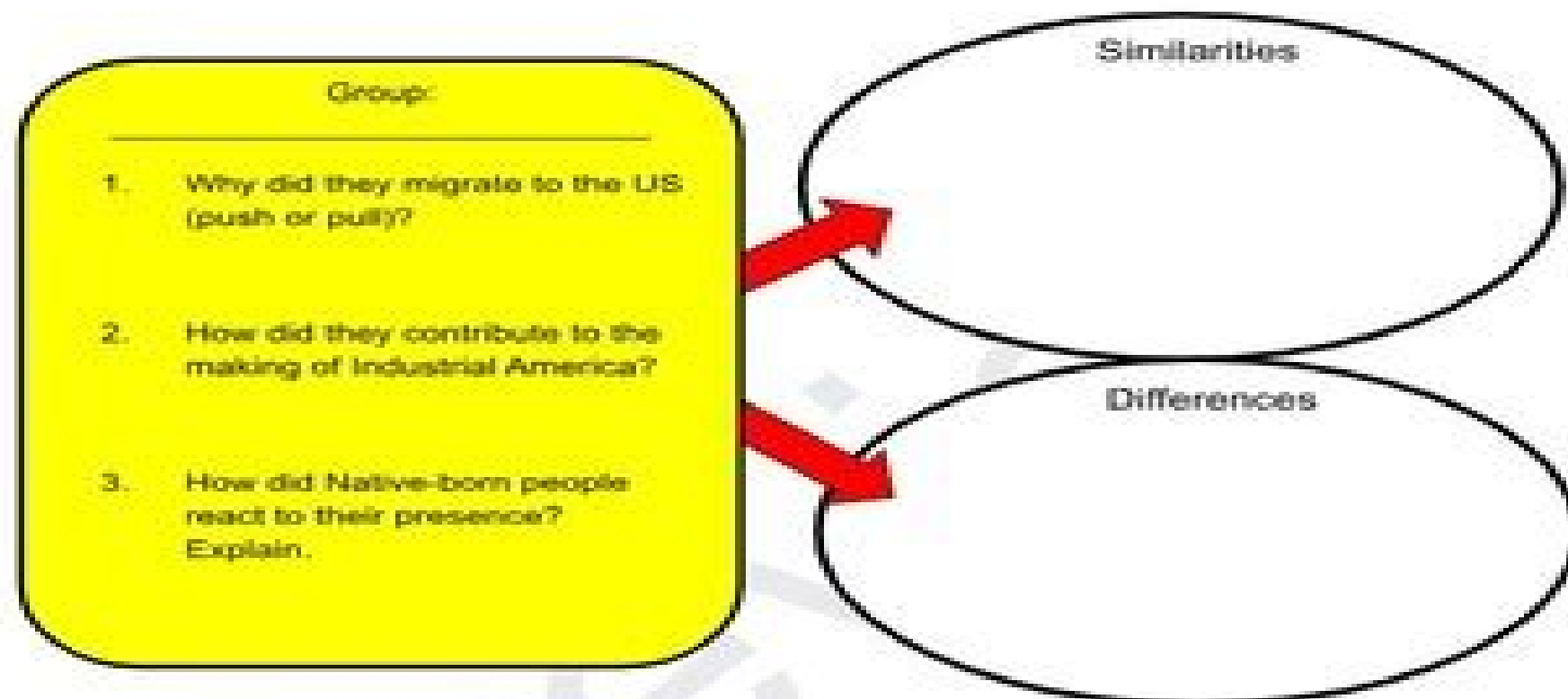

Perry,2012-08-08 During the Civil War Confederate military courts sentenced to death more soldiers from North Carolina than from any other state This study offers the first exploration of the service records of 450 of these wayward Confederates most often deserters Arranged by army corps division and brigade it chronicles their military trials and frequent executions and offers explanations of how the lucky and the clever were able to avoid their fate Focus on court activity by company allows for comparisons that emphasize the wide disparity in discipline within a regiment and brigade By stressing the effectiveness of these deadly decisions as deterrents to others this work maintains that an earlier and wider reliance on execution would have strengthened the Confederacy sufficiently to force a negotiated end to the war thus saving many Confederate and Federal lives *The United States Catalog* ,1921 Tumultuous Years Robert J. Streeter,2023-02-21 The military coup that toppled Chilean President Salvador Allende in 1973 led to one of the most repressive military dictatorships in Latin American history Although the coup s full origin remains one of the great mysteries of the Cold War most assume that powers in Washington were largely to blame given the long history of U S interventionism in Latin America These assumptions were only strengthened by ongoing suspicions about the Nixon administration s role in a failed campaign to prevent Allende s inauguration in 1970 Providing a comprehensive account of the Nixon administration s efforts to undermine and unseat Allende the book relies heavily on newly declassified records addressing several crucial questions regarding U S involvement The author explores several counterfactual scenarios to highlight important turning points and crucial decisions which contributed to the failure of Chilean democracy *The Irish and the Making of American Sport, 1835-1920* Patrick R. Redmond,2015-03-07 Jerrold Casway coined the phrase The Emerald Age of Baseball to describe the 1890s when so many Irish names dominated teams rosters But one can easily agree and expand that the period from the mid 1830s well into the first decade of the 20th century and assign the term to American sports in general This book covers the Irish sportsman from the arrival of James Deaf Burke in 1836 through to Jack B Kelly s rejection by Henley regatta and his subsequent gold medal at the 1920 Olympics It avoids recounting the various victories and defeats of the Irish sportsman seeking instead to deal with the complex interaction that he had with alcohol gambling

and Sunday leisure pleasures that were banned in most of America at some time or other between 1836 and 1920 This book also covers the Irish sportsman s close relations with politicians his role in labor relations his violent lifestyle and by contrast his participation in bringing respectability to sport It also deals with native Irish sports in America the part played by the Irish in Team USA s initial international sporting ventures and in the making and breaking of amateurism within sport
