\Rightarrow x^2 - x - 2 &= -x + 2 \\

\Rightarrow x &= \frac{1}{3}, x = -7 \quad (\text{Check! Both are extraneous.})

$$\Rightarrow \diamond = -3, \diamond = 1$$

$$\Rightarrow x^{1/3} = -3, x^{1/3} = 1$$

$$\Rightarrow x = (-3)^3 \text{ or } x = 1^3$$

$$\Rightarrow x = -27 \text{ or } x = 1$$

(Check! Both are valid.)

$\therefore$ The solution set is $\boxed{\{-27, 1\}}$.

$$15. \quad x^5 - 4x^3 - 8x^2 + 32 = 0$$

$\Rightarrow$ Grouping the first 2 terms and last 2 terms, then factoring out the common factors, we get

$$x^3(x^2 - 4) - 8(x^2 - 4) = 0$$

$$\Rightarrow (x^3 - 8)(x^2 - 4) = 0 \quad ((x^2 - 4) \text{ is a common factor.})$$

$$\Rightarrow (x-2)(x^2 + 2x + 4)(x+2)(x-2) = 0$$

$$\Rightarrow (x-2)^2(x+2)(x^2 + 2x + 4) = 0$$

$$\Rightarrow x = \pm 2$$

($x^2 + 2x + 4$) has no real roots.)

$\therefore$ The solution set is $\boxed{\{-2, 2\}}$.

$$16. \quad 1 < -3x + 4 \leq 10$$

$$\Rightarrow -3 < -3x \leq 6$$

$$\Rightarrow \frac{-3}{-3} > \frac{-3x}{-3} \geq \frac{6}{-3}$$

($-3 < 0$, so $<$ becomes $>$.)

$$\Rightarrow 1 > x \geq -2$$

$$\Rightarrow -2 \leq x < 1$$

$\therefore$ The solution set is $\boxed{[-2, 1)}$.

$$17. \quad x + 4 \leq 3x + 1 \leq 2x + 3$$

$$\Rightarrow x + 4 \leq 3x + 1 \text{ and } 3x + 1 \leq 2x + 3$$

$$\Rightarrow 3 \leq 2x \text{ and } x \leq 2$$

$$\Rightarrow x \in [\frac{3}{2}, +\infty) \cap (-\infty, 2] = [\frac{3}{2}, 2]$$

$\therefore$ The solution set is $\boxed{[\frac{3}{2}, 2]}$.

$$18. \quad 5 + x \leq 4x + 1 \leq -4 + 2x$$

$$\Rightarrow 5 + x \leq 4x + 1 \text{ and } 4x + 1 \leq -4 + 2x$$

$$\Rightarrow 4 \leq 3x \text{ and } 2x \leq -5$$

$$\Rightarrow x \in [\frac{4}{3}, +\infty) \cap (-\infty, -\frac{5}{2}] = \{\}$$

$\therefore$ The solution set is $\boxed{\{\} \text{ or } \phi}$.

$$19. \quad (x+4)(x-2) < -5x$$

$$\Rightarrow x^2 + 2x - 8 < -5x$$

$$\Rightarrow x^2 + 7x - 8 < 0$$
