Grohmann, 2005-12-15 Understanding Minimalism first published in 2005 is an introduction to the Minimalist Program the model of syntactic theory within generative linguistics Accessibly written it presents the basic principles and techniques of the minimalist program looking firstly at analyses within Government and Binding Theory the Minimalist Program's predecessor and gradually introducing minimalist alternatives Minimalist models of grammar are presented in a step by step fashion and the ways in which they contrast with GB analyses are clearly explained Spanning a decade of minimalist thinking this textbook will enable students to develop a feel for the sorts of questions and problems that minimalism invites and to master the techniques of minimalist analysis Over 100 exercises are provided encouraging them to put these skills into practice Understanding Minimalism will be an invaluable text for intermediate and advanced students of syntactic theory and will set a solid foundation for further study and research within Chomsky's minimalist framework

A Guide to Morphosyntax-phonology Interface Theories Tobias Scheer, 2011 This book reviews the history of the interface between morpho syntax and phonology roughly since World War II Structuralist and generative interface thinking is presented chronologically but also theory by theory from the point of view of a historically interested observer who however in the last third of the book distills lessons in order to assess present day interface theories and to establish a catalogue of properties that a correct interface theory should or must not have The book also introduces modularity the rationalist theory of the human cognitive system that underlies the generative approach to language from a Cognitive Science perspective Modularity is used as a referee for interface theories in the book Finally the book locates the interface debate in the landscape of current minimalist syntax and phase theory and fosters intermodular argumentation how can we use properties of morpho syntactic theory in order to argue for or against competing theories of phonology and vice versa

Reconstruction and Resumption in Indirect A'-Dependencies Martin Salzmann, 2017-04-24 This monograph investigates A dependencies in Standard German Alemannic and Dutch where the dislocated constituent is indirectly i e not transformationally related to the position where it is interpreted The study focuses on relative clauses and shows that an important part of the relativization system in these languages long relativization involves a hitherto ignored construction termed resumptive prolepsis This construction is characterized by base generation of the operator in the matrix middle field and a resumptive pronoun in the position of the variable It is shown that it involves short A movement in the matrix clause empty operator movement in the complement clause and an ellipsis operation that links the two operators While the link is directly visible in German and Dutch Swiss German provides a more abstract version of resumptive prolepsis Through a detailed examination of reconstruction effects and the properties of resumption in these constructions the book provides new evidence for the role of ellipsis in A movement and for a base generation analysis of resumption More generally it makes an important contribution to the modeling of long distance dependencies and the study of A syntax

The clausal syntax of German Sign Language Fabian Bross, 2020 This book presents a hypothesis based description of the clausal structure of German Sign Language DGS The structure of the book is based on the three clausal layers CP IP TP and VoiceP The main hypothesis is that scopal height is expressed iconically in sign languages the higher the scope of an operator the higher the articulator used for its expression The book was written with two audiences in mind On the one hand it addresses linguists interested in sign languages and on the other hand it addresses cartographers

Haddad, 2011-01-27 The book explores Adjunct Control in Assamese an Indo Aryan language spoken in North India by about 15 million people The author works within the Minimalist Program of syntactic theory Adjunct Control is a relation of co referentiality between two subjects one in the matrix clause and one in the adjunct clause of the same structure The relevant adjuncts in Assamese are non finite clauses commonly known as Conjunctive Participle CNP clauses Four types of Adjunct Control are examined i Forward Control in which only the matrix subject is pronounced ii Backward Control in which only the subordinate subject is pronounced iii Copy Control in which both subjects are pronounced and iv Expletive Control in which case the two control elements are expletives While Forward Control is a cross linguistically common control pattern Assamese also allows the other three less common structures The author analyzes Adjunct Control as movement and provides a detailed account of the conditions that drive and constrain each of the four types of control The theoretical implications are highlighted The book is unique both empirically and theoretically It is the first monograph which deals with Assamese generative syntax It is also the first book to explore control structures in a single understudied language in such detail In addition to Assamese the book provides data from Telugu Bengali Konkani Marathi Tamil and Hindi

Local Modelling of Non-Local Dependencies in Syntax Artemis Alexiadou, Tibor Kiss, Gereon Müller, 2012-12-06 Syntactic dependencies are often non local They can involve two positions in a syntactic structure whose correspondence cannot be captured by invoking concepts like minimal clause or predicate argument structure Relevant phenomena include long distance movement long distance reflexivization long distance agreement control non local deletion long distance case assignment consecutive tempore extended scope of negation and semantic binding of pronouns A recurring strategy pursued in many contemporary syntactic theories is to model cases of non local dependencies in a strictly local way by successively passing on the relevant information in small domains of syntactic structures The present volume brings together eighteen articles that investigate non local dependencies in movement agreement binding scope and deletion constructions from different theoretical backgrounds among them versions of the Minimalist Program HPSG and Categorical Grammar and based on evidence from a variety of typologically distinct languages This way advantages and disadvantages of local treatments of non local dependencies become evident Furthermore it turns out that local analyses of non local phenomena developed in different syntactic theories spanning the derivational declarative divide often may not only share identical research questions but also rely on identical research strategies

Gallego, 2012-04-10 This volume explores and develops the framework of phases so called Phase Theory first introduced in Chomsky 2000 The antecedents of such framework go back to the well known notion of cycle which concerns broader notions such as compositionality locality and economy conditions Within generative grammar this idea of the cycle took a concrete form in the fifties with Chomsky Halle and Lukoff's 1955 pioneering work on stress later on extended in Chomsky Halle 1968 Halle Vergnaud 1987 and further applied to morpho phonology Mascar 1976 and Kiparski 1982 semantics Jackendoff 1969 and syntax Chomsky 1965 1973 In recent years several attempts have tried to refine and reformulate the cycle Freidin 1999 Lasnik 2006 Uriagereka 2011 Such was the goal behind explorations on bounding nodes Chomsky 1973 and barriers Chomsky 1986 for which there is substantial empirical evidence showing how computation proceeds in a step by step fashion Much work within minimalism has been devoted to investigate the nature of phases and their relevance for other areas of linguistic inquiry Although it has been argued that phases have natural correlates at the interfaces it is still unclear what the defining properties of these domains are whether they can help us understand language acquisition language variation or language evolution This book aims at addressing these questions sharpening our understanding about phases and the nature of the Faculty of Language
